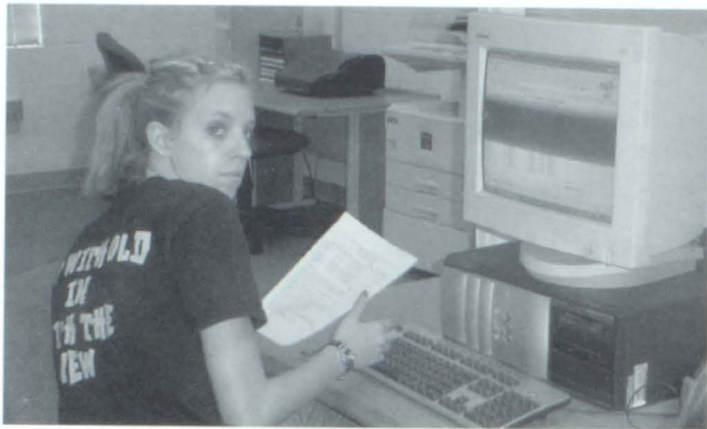
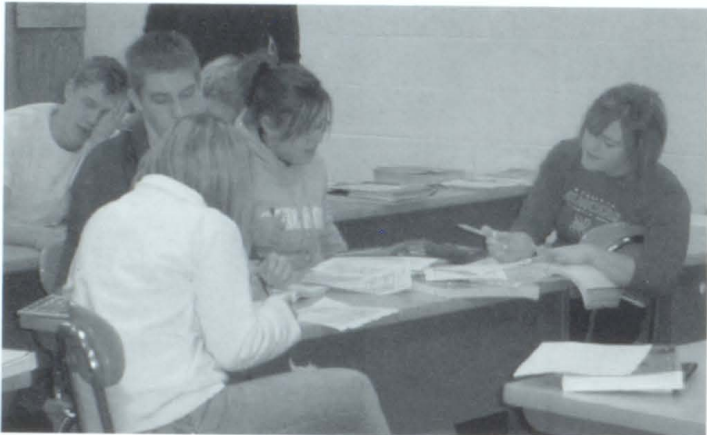


# Seniors

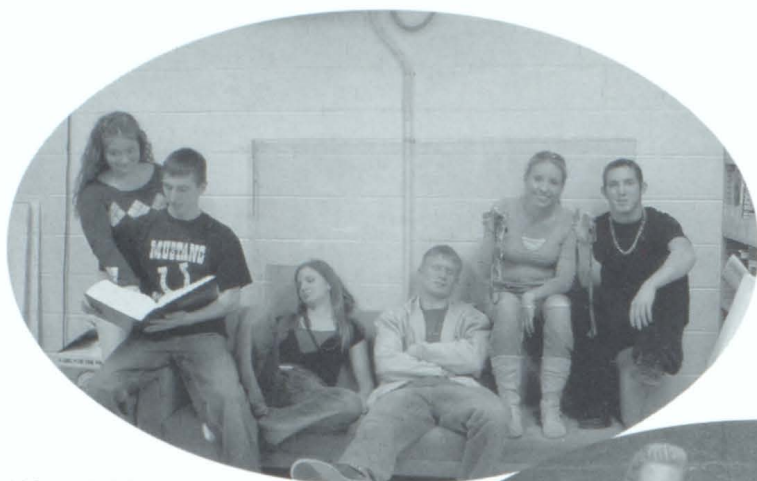
