The Mustang City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, September 3, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in the Mustang Municipal Building Council Chambers. Notice of the meeting was posted as required on Thursday, August 29, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. in compliance with the Open Meeting Law, 25 O.S., Section 301, et. seq.

**A. CALL TO ORDER**

**Mayor Grider** called the meeting to order at **7:00 p.m.**

Expressed that the code only is enforced if someone complains. Ms. Schramm gave several examples of how roosters are not nuisance animals.

**Mayor Grider** asked the Councilmembers if they had anything to report in their respective Wards:

**Vice Mayor Ray** stated his ward was quiet. **Vice Mayor Ray** wanted to say Happy Birthday to the City Manager.

**Councilman Leete** state his ward was quiet and reiterated the Birthday wishes to City Manager Rooney.

**Councilman Waugh** reported a few calls within his ward regarding geese. Stated that neighbors are feeding the geese and those with concerns reached out to the neighborhood trying to resolve the issue within the community.

**Councilman McKenzie** reported his ward was quiet and that discussions with **City Manager Rooney** regarding street lights was ongoing.

**Councilman Sholund** reported a few emails and wanted to give praise to the Community Center. Specifically to "Jo & Nicole" for assisting him with the retrieval of his sons shoes. They had located them and brought them to **Councilman Sholund** in the parking lot.

**Mayor Grider** reminded all that Western Days is this weekend. He also noted that he received a call regarding water backing up in a house. 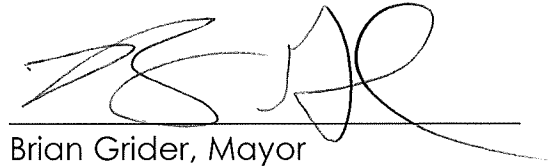
**J. ADJOURNMENT**
