The training division is looking for interested parties to attend outside conferences. These are a great opportunity to learn new and cutting edge material in the EMS profession while having a great time in the process. We will, (and have) received training for new narcotic medications, inventory and packaging. We will likely be getting rid of Romazicon. Biometric narcotic safes are still in progress. We will also be receiving training for core temp thermometers and the cyanokit.

We are working on some type of procedure as well as in-service for psych calls to provide guidance for crews in these often difficult situations.

Per the training division, we will have EMS minimum standards in the near future. The EMS committee has been tasked with making the standards.

Be aware of medication shortages and/or different packaging. Capt. Bitner will do his best to make sure we have what we need and how we need it.

We are moving forward with Greenline disposable laryngoscope equipment. There will be a wholesale change of all laryngoscope equipment. I believe the handles will be reusable.

We will soon have updated medic check off sheets as well as an a list of approved station supplies.
