**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS, TO
SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE ARKANSAS
RURAL HEALTH TRANSFORMATION PROGRAM UNDER THE HEART
INITIATIVE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Springdale, Arkansas, has determined that improving healthcare access, preventive health outcomes, and long-term health sustainability is vital to the health, safety, welfare, and economic well-being of its employees; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas has established the Arkansas Rural Health Transformation Program to support innovative, sustainable healthcare models that improve health outcomes, strengthen prevention, reduce chronic disease, and lower long-term healthcare costs; and

WHEREAS, the HEART Initiative — Healthy Eating, Active Recreation, & Transformation — is a component of the Arkansas Rural Health Transformation Program focused on prevention, nutrition, physical activity, chronic disease reduction, and improved population health outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springdale seeks to apply for grant funding under the HEART Initiative to support the Springdale Health Transformation Initiative, a prevention-focused employee health program designed to improve metabolic health, reduce chronic disease risk, support early detection, and lower long-term healthcare costs; and

WHEREAS, the proposed initiative may include, without limitation, advanced health screening, precision blood panels, genetic methylation testing, personalized care plans, telehealth-supported coaching, supplementation, lifestyle and nutrition support, and outcome tracking to measure health improvements and cost savings; and

WHEREAS, the Springdale City Council finds that submitting an application for such funding is in the best interest of the City and supports the City's efforts to promote preventive health, employee wellness, and innovative healthcare cost-reduction strategies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS, that:**

The Mayor, or the Mayor’s designated representative, is hereby authorized to prepare, formalize, and submit a grant application to the Arkansas Rural Health Transformation Program under the HEART Initiative for the purpose of supporting the Springdale Health Transformation Initiative.

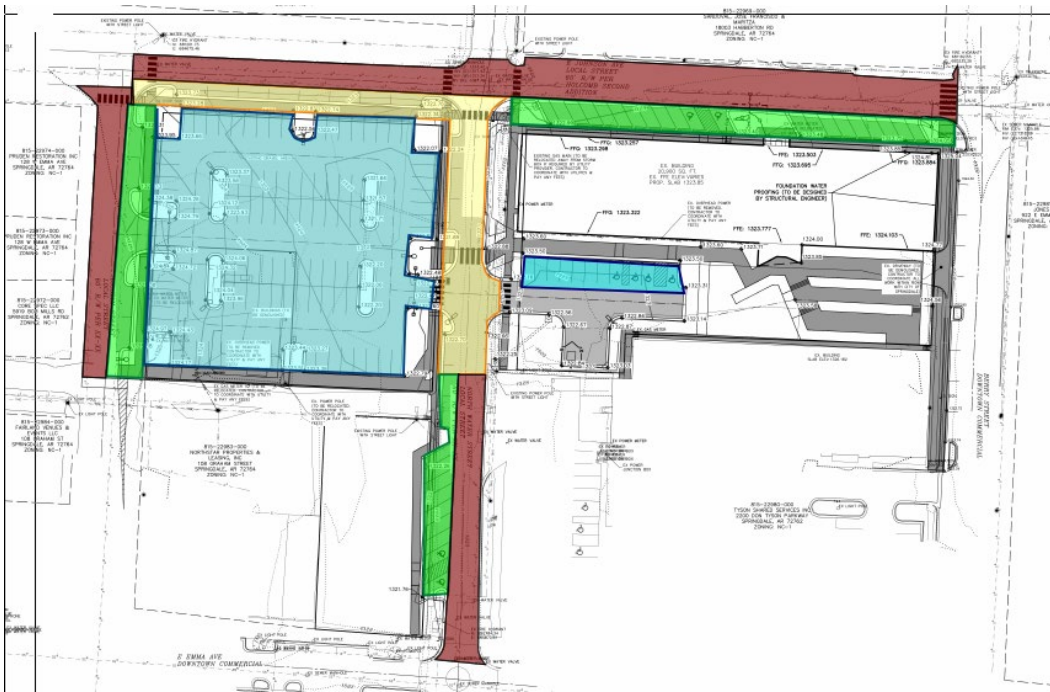

**A RESOLUTION COMMITTING MATCH FUNDING FOR THE CITY'S FISCAL
YEAR 2025-2026 FEDERAL RAILROAD ADMINISTRATION (FRA) RAILROAD
CROSSING ELIMINATION (CROSSING SAFETY) GRANT PROGRAM
APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Railroad Administration (FRA), is accepting grant applications for the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Railroad Crossing Elimination (Crossing Safety) Grant Program (Funding Opportunity ID: FR-RCE-26-001), with applications due no later than June 8, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Crossing Elimination Program provides funding for highway-rail or pathway-rail grade crossing improvement projects that focus on improving the safety and mobility of people and goods, as authorized under Section 22305 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (49 U.S.C. § 22909); and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Fayetteville and Springdale, in collaboration with the Arkansas & Missouri Railroad, were previously awarded a 2022 Railroad Crossing Elimination Grant in the amount of \$576,000.00 to conduct planning activities to scope improvement projects at various at-grade crossings along a 14-mile corridor to improve mobility and enhance safety for the area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springdale intends to submit an application to the FRA Railroad Crossing Elimination (Crossing Safety) Grant Program for the construction of a grade-separated crossing at County Line Rd, at a total proposed project cost of Twenty-Eight Million Five Hundred Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$28,508,780.00); and

WHEREAS, the City of Springdale is requesting Twenty-Two Million Eight Hundred Seven Thousand Twenty-Four Dollars (\$22,807,024.00) in federal funds from the FRA Railroad Crossing Elimination (Crossing Safety) Grant Program for the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Crossing Elimination Program requires a commitment of non-federal matching funds in an amount not less than twenty percent (20%) of the total eligible project cost; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springdale's required non-federal match for the proposed project is Five Million Seven Hundred One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars (\$5,701,756.00); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this project will improve public safety, enhance mobility, reduce traffic delays, and eliminate the risk of vehicle-train collisions at the

Randall Wobbe Drive crossing for the benefit of the residents and traveling public of the City of Springdale.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS, that:

Section 1. The City of Springdale hereby commits Five Million Seven Hundred One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars (\$5,701,756.00) in non-federal matching funds to the construction of a grade-separated crossing over Randall Wobbe Drive, as proposed in the City's FRA Railroad Crossing Elimination (Crossing Safety) Grant Program application, to be paid out of the Street Fund, General Fund and/or Bond Funds.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to submit the grant application, and to execute a grant agreement with the Federal Railroad Administration in the event that the project is selected for award.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

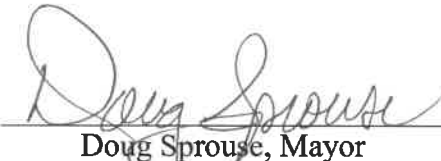

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDING THE 2026 BUDGET FOR THE
SPRINGDALE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO RECLASSIFY CERTAIN FIREFIGHTER
POSITIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Springdale previously authorized twelve firefighter positions in connection with the staffing plan for Fire Station 10;

WHEREAS, the construction of Fire Station 10 will be completed in the coming months;

WHEREAS, the Springdale Fire Department has reviewed the operational and supervisory needs associated with Fire Station 10 and has requested that six of the twelve authorized firefighter positions be reclassified in order to provide appropriate command structure, shift supervision, and apparatus operation for the station;

WHEREAS, the requested amendment would reclassify six of the twelve positions as follows: three firefighter positions to Captain positions and three firefighter positions to Driver/Operator positions;

WHEREAS, the proposed changes do not increase the total number of authorized Fire Station 10 positions, but instead adjust the classification of six previously approved positions to better align staffing with operational needs;

WHEREAS, the projected 2026 budget impact for the six Fire Station 10 position changes is approximately \$33,877, based on the Fire Department's projected salary and benefit analysis;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the requested position reclassifications are necessary and appropriate to support the safe and effective operation of Fire Station 10.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes an amendment to the 2026 budget and authorized position schedule for the Springdale Fire Department to reclassify six of the twelve firefighter positions approved for Fire Station 10 as follows:

1. Three firefighter positions shall be reclassified as Captain positions; and
2. Three firefighter positions shall be reclassified as Driver/Operator positions.

Section 2. The Mayor, Finance Director, Human Resources Director, and Fire Chief are authorized to take all necessary administrative actions to implement the position changes, including updates to the City's position schedule, payroll records, salary classifications, and related budget accounts.

Section 3. The projected budget impact associated with these six position changes shall be incorporated into the 2026 budget amendment in accordance with the Fire Department's submitted salary and benefit analysis. The uploaded budget worksheet lists individual reclassification impacts for three Driver/Operator-related changes and three Captain-related changes, totaling approximately \$33,877 for this portion of the request.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CERTAIN FIRE DEPARTMENT JOB DESCRIPTION AND CLASSIFICATION CHANGES, AUTHORIZING RELATED AMENDMENTS TO THE 2026 BUDGET AND POSITION SCHEDULE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has requested that the City consider reclassifying one Captain – Logistics position to Battalion Chief – Logistics; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has further requested that two Battalion Chief positions, including the Fire Marshal position and Resource Development / Training-related position, be reclassified to Division Chief positions; and

WHEREAS, these proposed changes are intended to better reflect the scope of responsibility, level of command authority, administrative oversight, and specialized departmental leadership required for these positions; and

WHEREAS, the projected 2026 budget impact for the three classification changes is approximately \$6,122, based on the Fire Department’s submitted salary and benefit analysis; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the proposed job description and classification changes are appropriate and in the best interest of the City and the Springdale Fire Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the following Fire Department classification changes:

1. Reclassification of one Captain – Logistics position to Battalion Chief – Logistics;
2. Reclassification of the Battalion Chief – Fire Marshal position to Division Chief – Fire Marshal; and
3. Reclassification of the Battalion Chief – Resource Development / Training-related position to Division Chief.

Section 2. The City Council hereby approves the corresponding job descriptions, as amended by Human Resources, for the affected positions.

Section 3. The Mayor, Finance Director, Human Resources Director, and Fire Chief are authorized to make all necessary administrative changes to implement the approved reclassifications, including updates to job descriptions, pay grades, position titles, payroll records, budget accounts, and the City’s authorized position schedule.

Section 4. The projected 2026 budget impact associated with these three administrative classification changes is approximately \$6,122, based on the Fire Department's submitted salary and benefit analysis. This amount includes the proposed reclassification of the Fire Marshal position, the Resource Development / Training-related Battalion Chief position, and the Logistics position.
