**A RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY APPOINTING REX BAILEY TO FILL THE VACANCY
IN WARD 2, POSITION 2, ON THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGDALE,
ARKANSAS.**

WHEREAS, Aaron Huntley has resigned from his position as the Ward 2, Position 2, member of the Springdale City Council, creating a vacancy in that office; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated sections 14-43-411 and 14-42-103(a)(2)(A), the City Council has called a special election to be held on November 3, 2026, to fill the vacant position for the remainder of the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated section 14-42-103(a)(2)(B)(i) authorizes the City Council, after calling a special election, to appoint a qualified elector of the City to serve temporarily until the office is filled through the special election; and

WHEREAS, Rex Bailey is a qualified elector of the City of Springdale and resides in Ward 2; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that temporarily appointing Rex Bailey will provide continued representation for Ward 2 and continuity in the work of the City Council,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS, that:

Section 1. Rex Bailey is hereby appointed to temporarily fill the vacancy in Ward 2, Position 2, on the Springdale City Council.

Section 2. Mr. Bailey's appointment shall become effective upon his taking the oath of office required by Arkansas Code Annotated section 14-42-106 and shall continue until the person elected at the November 3, 2026 special election is duly certified, has taken the oath of office, and is qualified to serve. The person elected at the special election shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION
OF A CONTRACT FOR THE CITY OF
SPRINGDALE 2026 STREET OVERLAY PROJECT**

WHEREAS, The Public Works Department has budgeted for the 2026 Street Overlay Project, and;

WHEREAS, the competitive bidding process provided by Arkansas law was utilized by the City of Springdale Public Works Department to obtain bids for the Overlay Project, and;

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder was APAC-Central, Inc. in the amount of \$1,699,733.60

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
FOR THE CITY OF SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS**, that

Section 1. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a contract with APAC-Central, Inc. for the 2026 Street Overlay Project in amount not to exceed \$1,699,733.60 to be paid from the 2026 Public Works Budget.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to approve additional construction change orders as long as the cumulative total of the additional change orders does not exceed 10% of the original contract price.

WHEREAS, the 2023 Bond Program authorizes the acquisition of facility and equipment improvements intended to enhance public amenities and improve the quality of life for Springdale residents; and

WHEREAS, the Springdale Parks and Recreation Department desires to purchase new bleachers for the Springdale Recreation Center as part of the improvements authorized under the 2023 Bond Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department is authorized to purchase the necessary equipment through a cooperative purchasing agreement authorized by Arkansas law; and,

WHEREAS, the Department has requested authorization to purchase new bleachers for the Springdale Recreation Center at a cost not to exceed \$186,398.30, to be paid from the 2023 Parks and Recreation Bond Fund

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS, that the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to purchase new bleachers for the Springdale Recreation Center from Swift Recreation, LLC., for \$186,398.30, to be paid from the 2023 Parks and Recreation Bond Fund.

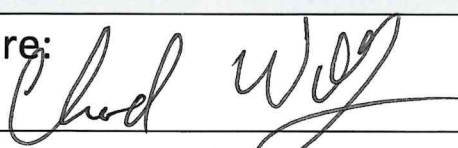

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 78 OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SPRINGDALE,
ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council for the City of Springdale, Arkansas, that Chapter 78 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Springdale, Arkansas, needs to be amended to include provisions regarding the use of electric motorcycles on the various trails located within the City of Springdale, Arkansas;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Springdale, Arkansas, that Chapter 78 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Springdale, Arkansas, be amended to include a new Article addressing the use of electric motorcycles on the various trails located within the City of Springdale, Arkansas.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE
CITY OF SPRINGDALE, ARKANSAS:**

Section 1: Chapter 78 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Springdale is hereby amended to create a new Article, to be known as Chapter 78, Article III, to provide as follows:

ARTICLE III. – TRAIL USE CODE.

Sec. 78-60. - Operation of Vehicles and Use of City Trails.

- (a) No golf carts or comparable sized vehicles nor any gas powered vehicles or electric vehicles with motor outputs exceeding 750 watts (1 horsepower) (except city maintenance or emergency vehicles) shall be driven or operated on the Razorback Greenway or any other city trail as designated on the Master Trail Plan.
- (b) It is hereby declared unlawful to park or operate a motor vehicle on or along any city trail that has been or is hereafter so posted by the city.

Any motor vehicle that is being utilized for a legitimate government purpose or emergency shall be exempt for the provision of this section.

Section 2: All other provisions of Chapter 78 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Springdale, Arkansas, not specifically modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: Emergency Clause. It is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Springdale, Arkansas, shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
