The salaries listed above are based on 10-month employment for the 2026-2027 school year. Salary plans are determined on an annual basis and salary advancement is not guaranteed. Pay increases are based on the annual pay raise budget approved by the Board of Trustees.

Salaries are determined individually with consideration for job-related experience and credentials.

Note: This pay grade is the only one which recognizes Bachelors and Masters Degrees. Should a person be promoted to a higher pay grade, the person will no longer be eligible for the \$1,500 Master's Degree Stipend.

Employees on this paygrade will *NOT* be eligible for the Teacher Incentive Allotment.

DOI (Non Certified Teachers) will no longer be placed on a teacher hiring chart. DOI teachers will be paid \$54,500.
