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SOLICITATION AND NOTICE FOR BIDS

INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER 19 OF CARTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA (“Ardmore City Schools”) hereinafter referred to as “District” is soliciting sealed proposals for repair work to the Ardmore High School Building located at 701 Veterans Blvd. Ardmore, OK 73401.

Bid Documents may be obtained from the Ardmore City Schools Administration Building and <https://www.ardmoreschools.org/page/operations> or go to Ardmore Schools website and click on departments and then Operations to view or download the bid documents. District reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities or minor irregularities in any bid. Completed bid forms must be placed within a sealed outer envelope, labeled and completed as follows: **Bid Documents, Repair of Ardmore High School Building, Name of Bidder, Address of Bidder, Phone Number of Bidder.** Bids not received prior to the date and time specified above will not be considered and will be returned unopened.

A **mandatory walk through** of the High School Building and the required repairs will occur on **June 16, 2026 beginning at 10:00 a.m..**

The bidding process will be in compliance with the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 (“the Act”). Any party submitting a sealed proposal for the identified project shall be required to comply with all terms, conditions and provisions of the Act. Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 5% of the bid via cashier check, certified check, or surety bond. Failure to include a total price per project will result in exclusion from consideration. By this notice, all provisions of the Act apply to this project and are incorporated into notice by reference. Failure to comply with the above bid requirements will result in the return of unopened Bid Proposal.

Attention is called to the fact that a designated completion date for this project site will be established based on the number of calendar days, as stated in the accepted bid, required to complete the Project work. Bids will be opened on **June 24, 2026 starting at 11:00 a.m.** Bids will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, taking into consideration price, past history and working relationship with the District, time to start the Project, time for Project Completion, work experience on similar projects, and references. Each Bidder must include (in the space provided on the Bid Form) the number of calendar days, which the Bidder will require to complete the specified Project. All bidders are required to meet the qualifications established in the bid documents. The District shall provide a local bid preference in accordance with state law.

Upon the District’s receipt of an acceptable bid, the contract will be awarded within thirty days after the opening of bids and the written contract executed by the District within sixty days thereafter.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

PART 1 GENERAL

1 CONTRACT INSTRUCTIONS

The Owner's Construction Agreement shall apply to this Project and must be completed by the Bidder and signed and returned with the Bidder's Bid Packet.

2 BID FORM and BID PACKET INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Bids shall be submitted on the Bid Form with all Bid Documents. All blanks must be completed. Bids made on a copy of the Bid Form are acceptable. Bids carrying riders, alterations or qualifications which modify the amount of the Bid or condition the Bid in any way may be rejected as irregular. In case of a difference between written words and figures in the Bid Form, the amount stated in written words shall govern.

Completed Bid Forms must be placed within a sealed outer envelope, labeled and completed as follows: **Bid Documents, Repair of Ardmore High School Building, Name of Bidder, Address of Bidder, Phone Number of Bidder**

The sealed envelope must also include the following Bid Documents in the Bid Packet:

- B. Bid Bond: Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond pledging that the Bidder will enter into a Contract with the Owner on the terms stated in his Bid and will furnish a Statutory Bond, Warranty Bond, and Performance Bond prior to execution of the Contract as required for covering the faithful performance of the Contract and the payment of all obligations arising thereunder.

3 CONDITIONS RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION

- A. Bidders are required to inform themselves fully of conditions relating to construction and labor under which the work will be performed. Contractor shall employ such methods and means in carrying out of this work as will not cause any interruption or interference with Owner's daily operations.
- B. Examination of Premises: Before submitting proposal for this work, each bidder shall examine the premises, confirm all utility locations, sizes, pressures, etc., and satisfy himself as to existing conditions under which he will be obliged to operate. Bidders may remove portions of ceiling tile to inspect existing conditions.

4 INTERPRETATION OR CORRECTION OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

- A. Bidders shall promptly notify the Owner of any ambiguity, inconsistency or error which they may discover upon examination of the bidding documents. Requests for clarification or interpretation of the Bidding Documents shall be made in writing by email to:

- B. Interpretations, corrections or changes of the bidding documents will be made by the Owner's addendum only. Information transmitted in any other manner will not be binding and Bidders shall not rely upon its accuracy.
- C. Addenda are written or graphic instruments issued by the Owner before the execution of the Contract which modify or interpret the bidding documents by addition, deletion, clarification or correction. Addenda will be issued to each Bidder who has received or requested a complete set of bidding documents. Each Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of addenda on the Bid Form.
- D. The Owner will not be responsible for any verbal explanations or verbal interpretations of the Bidding Documents.
- E. If documents illustrate scope of work in two different methods and no clarification is given to bidder, bidder is to price the higher of the two methods.

5 SUBSTITUTIONS

- A. The materials, products and equipment described in the Bidding Documents establish a standard of required function, dimension, appearance, and quality to be met by any proposed substitution.
- B. No substitution will be considered before receipt of Bids unless written request for approval has been received by the Owner at least ten days before the date for receipt of Bids. Each such request shall include the name of the material or equipment for which it is to be substituted and a complete description of the proposed substitute including drawings, cuts, performance and test data and any other information necessary for an evaluation. A statement setting forth any changes in other materials, equipment or other Work that incorporation of the substitute would require shall be included. The burden of proof of the merit of the proposed substitute is upon the proposer. The Owner's decision of approval or disapproval of the proposed substitution shall be final.

6 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

- A. Bonds: Before Owner's execution of the Contract, the Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded will be communicated to all prospective Bidders by issue of an addendum and shall be required to furnish the following bonds:
 1. Performance Bond - 100% of Contract Amount
 2. Statutory Bond - 100% of Contract Amount
 3. Warranty Bond - 100% of Contract Amount

Bonds shall be executed on forms substantially identical to the form included in this Bid Packet.

- B. Bids may be withdrawn in writing received from Bidders prior to the time fixed for opening. Negligence on the part of the Bidder in preparing the bid confers no right for the withdrawal of the bid after it has been opened.

7 ETHICS IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING

By submitting their bid, Bidders certify that their bids are made without collusion or fraud and that they have not offered or received any kickbacks or inducements from any other bidder, supplier, manufacturer or subcontractor in connection with their proposal, and that they have not conferred on any public employee having official responsibility for this procurement transaction any payment, loan, subscription, advance, deposit of money, services or anything of more than nominal value, present or promised unless consideration of substantially equal or greater value was exchanged. A duplicate of the Invoice Affidavit/Non- Kickback form within this Bid Packet must be signed, notarized, and submitted with each and every copy of AIA Document G702, “Application and Certificate for Payment”, that is presented to the Owner for payment.

8 NON-DISCRIMINATION

Bidders agree Bidders will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, sex, age, or national origin. Bidders will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment without regard to their race, religion, color, sex, age or national origin. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff-, or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. Bidders agree to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices setting for the provisions of this non-discrimination clause.

9 SITE INVESTIGATION

Bidders shall visit site and acquaint themselves with site conditions before bidding at the walkthrough of Ardmore High School on **June 16, 2026 at 10AM.** Bidders may make their own investigations to satisfy themselves with site conditions.

10 BIDDER’S QUALIFICATIONS

Each prospective Bidder is required to submit a Contractor's Qualification Statement on the form provided within this Bid Packet. Submittal of an advertising brochure is not permitted. Such statement shall be notarized. A financial statement is not required with the qualification statement; however, the apparent three lowest Bidders may be required to submit a notarized current statement within 72 hours after the bid opening.

At the time of the opening of bids, each bidder will be presumed to have read and to be thoroughly familiar with the Bid Documents (including all addenda). The failure or omission of any Bidder to examine any form, instrument, or document shall in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation in respect of his bid. By submitting a bid, the Bidder covenants and agrees that they are satisfied, from their own investigation of the conditions to be met, that they fully understand their obligation and that they will not make any claim for, or have right to cancellation or relief from the contract because of any misunderstanding or lack of information.

PROJECT SUMMARY

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

- A. Drawings and general provisions of the Construction Agreement and all Bidding Documents incorporated thereto apply to this Section.

1.2 PROJECT INFORMATION

- A. Project Identification: -Repair Work for Ardmore High School Building
- B. Project Location: 701 Veterans Blvd Ardmore, OK 73401
- C. Owner: Ardmore City Schools (Independent School District No. 19 of Carter County, OK)
- D. Owner's Representative: Scott Foster, Director of Operations.

1.3 WORK COVERED BY CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

- A. The Work of the Project (“Work”) is defined by the Contract Documents and consists of the following:

Repair work for damage caused by flooding in rooms 56, 57, 58, 59 (computer lab), 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, and 68 including, but not limited to, the following:

- a. Replacing framing;
- b. Installing drywall and gypsum;
- c. Removing and replacing ceiling grid, ceiling tiles, and acoustic tiles in ten rooms;
- d. Install sound board on all demo walls before installing sheetrock over it;
- e. Texture and paint all sheetrock walls;
- f. Taping and bedding new gypsum walls;
- g. Fabricating and installing millwork to match water damaged millwork;
- h. Installing laminate CLAD cabinets;
- i. Removing and replacing flooring with carpet squares and/or tile flooring in all ten rooms with cove base;
- j. Retiling a hallway corridor;
- k. Repairing, replacing, and reattaching damaged studs;
- l. Install cabinets on one entire wall in nine classrooms to include countertop material, doors, closures, knobs, backsplash, and stops;
- m. Cleaning and removal of debris; and
- n. Replacement of electrical outlets, data cabling, etc to be performed outside of the project by skilled trades.

- B. Type of Contract

- 1. General Contractor to perform work with skilled trades employed as required.

1.4 ACCESS TO SITE

- A. General: Contractor shall have full use of Project site for construction operations during construction period, which shall begin no earlier than **JUNE 29th, 2026** and completed no later than **DECEMBER 18th, 2026**. Contractor's use of Project site is limited only by Owner's right to perform work or to retain other contractors on portions of Project.

1.5 WORK RESTRICTIONS

- A. Work Restrictions, General: Comply with restrictions on construction operations.
 - 1. Comply with limitations on use of public streets and other requirements of authorities having jurisdiction.
 - 2. Comply with limitations by Owner for use of site.

- B. On Site Work Hours: Limit work to normal business working hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except as otherwise indicated.
 - 1. Weekend Hours: As negotiated with Owner.
 - 2. Early Morning Hours: As negotiated with Owner.
 - 3. Hours for Utility Shutdowns: As negotiated with Owner.
 - 4. Hours for noisy activities: As negotiated with Owner.
- C. Existing Utility Interruptions: Do not interrupt utilities serving facilities occupied by Owner or others unless permitted under the following conditions and then only after providing temporary utility services according to requirements indicated:
 - 1. Notify Owner not less than two working days in advance of proposed utility interruptions.
 - 2. Obtain Owner's written permission before proceeding with utility interruptions.
- D. Noise, Vibration, and Odors: Coordinate operations that may result in high levels of noise and vibration, odors, or other disruption to Owner occupancy with Owner.
 - 1. Notify Owner and Contractor not less than two working days in advance of proposed disruptive operations.
 - 2. Obtain Owner's written permission before proceeding with disruptive operations.
- E. Nonsmoking Building: Smoking is not permitted within the building or on property.
- F. Controlled Substances: Use of tobacco products and other controlled substances within the building or on property is not permitted.
- G. Employee Identification: Provide identification tags for Contractor personnel working on the Project site. Require personnel to utilize identification tags at all times.
- H. Employee Screening: Comply with Owner's and Contractor's requirements regarding drug and background screening of Contractor personnel working on the Project site.
 - 1. Maintain list of approved screened personnel with Owner's Representative and Contractor.

1.6 WATER DAMAGE

Contractor will be responsible for any water damages incurred as a result of construction related leaks during the construction period.

1.7 PERMITS

Contractor to apply for, obtain, and pay for permits required to perform the Work. Submit copies to Owner.

1.8 CODES

Comply with all applicable codes and regulations of authorities having jurisdiction. Submit copies of inspection reports, notices and similar communications to Owner and Contractor.

1.9 DIMENSIONS

Verify all dimensions indicated on Drawings with field dimensions before fabrication or ordering of materials. Do not scale Drawings.

1.10 SPECIFICATIONS

- A. Correlation and Intent of the Contract Documents: The Contract Documents are complimentary, and what is required by one shall be as binding as if required by all.
- B. Obligation of Bidder / Contractor: This Paragraph is in addition to Bidder Instructions, Technical Specifications and the Construction Agreement. At the time of the opening of bids each bidder will be presumed to have inspected the site and to have read and be thoroughly familiar with the Construction Documents, including but not limited to Technical Specifications, Pictures, Drawings, and all Addenda. The failure or omission of bidder / Contractor to examine any and all

forms, instruments or documents shall in no way relieve and bidder / Contractor from any obligation required by the Documents or in respect to his bid. Failure to familiarize oneself fully of the conditions related to the Project and Documents will not relieve the successful bidder / Contractor of his obligation to furnish all material and labor necessary to carry out the Work. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to provide all materials, equipment and labor to provide a complete and working assembly or system even though some material or equipment may not be shown on the Drawings. By submitting his bid the Contractor acknowledges that adequate information has been provided for the successful completion of the Project. Should a bidder find discrepancies in or omissions from the Documents, or should he be in doubt as to their meaning, he should at once notify the Owner in writing, who will send written instructions to all bidders

CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made, effective __, 2026, by and between **INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 19 OF CARTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA a/k/a Ardmore City Schools** ("Owner"), and _____ ("Contractor").

RECITALS:

- A. On _____, 2026, Owner invited bids for the repair of the property it owns and is known as Ardmore High School building located at 701 Veterans Blvd Ardmore, OK 73401 ("Property"). Specifically, Owner desires to have the building and related improvements located on the Property repaired from water damage (the "Project").
- B. Contractor, in response to the advertisement soliciting bids, submitted its bid to the Owner in the manner and at the time specified all in accordance with the terms of the Solicitation and Notice for Bids.
- C. Owner has determined that the Contractor is the lowest responsible bidder for completion of the Project and has awarded to the Contractor a contract for performance of the Work.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained in this Agreement and other good and valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

1. Documents Comprising the Agreement. The Contract Documents consist of this Agreement, the Solicitation and Notice for Bids, Instructions to Bidders, Summary, Technical Specifications, Drawings, Contractor's completed Bid Form, Contractor's completed Bid Bond, Contractor's completed six affidavits, and Contractor's Qualification Statement ("Contract Documents"). The foregoing Contract Documents form the Agreement and are as fully a part of the Agreement as if attached hereto or repeated herein. This Agreement represents the entire integrated Agreement between the parties hereto and supersedes prior negotiations, representations or agreements, either written or oral.

2. Work. Owner hereby engages and employs Contractor, as an independent contractor, to construct and complete the Project. Contractor accepts such employment and agrees to furnish, at its own cost and expense, all labor, tools, equipment and materials required to complete the Project as designated, described and required by the Contract Documents, except to the extent specifically indicated in the Contract Documents to be the responsibility of the Owner or others (the "Work"). All Work under this Agreement shall be done in a good and workmanlike manner in strict accordance with the Contract Documents and to the entire satisfaction of the Owner.

3. Date of Commencement and Substantial Completion. For purposes of this Agreement, Substantial Completion shall be defined as that date by which the Contractor has sufficiently completed the Work to be performed under this Agreement, such that the building may be utilized by the Owner for its intended purpose leaving only minor defects and punch list items to be corrected or completed. The Work specified in this Agreement shall begin within ten (10) days after the receipt by the Contractor of the Owner's Notice to Proceed. The Contractor shall achieve Substantial Completion of the entire Work within the number of days specified in Contractor's Bid but not later than **DECEMBER 18, 2026** (the "Contract Time"), subject to adjustments of this Contract Time as may be agreed by Owner and Contractor to recognize delays caused by inclement weather or other causes outside the reasonable control of the Contractor. Contractor shall promptly correct all defects in material and workmanship as directed by the Owner for a period of one year after Substantial Completion of the Work.

4. Labor and Equipment. Contractor will provide, at Contractor's sole cost and expense, all labor, equipment, materials and supplies necessary for the proper execution of the Work.

5. Permits and Compliance with Laws. Contractor will secure, at Contractor's sole cost and expense, all permits, licenses, franchises and consents required by law or necessary to perform the Work under this Agreement and will give all notices and pay all fees and otherwise comply with all applicable federal, city, county and state laws, ordinances, rules and regulations pertaining to such Work, including, without limitation, rules and regulations of Ardmore, Oklahoma; of the Environmental Protection Agency; the United States Department of Transportation; the United States Department of Labor; the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality; and the Oklahoma Department of Labor. These requirements include, but are not limited to, completing any required waste manifests and shipment records required by such law and ensuring the appropriate transportation and disposal of regulated asbestos.

6. Cost of Work. The Owner shall pay the Contractor for the performance of the Work specified in this Agreement, and the Contractor shall accept as full payment for its performance of the Work, the sum of \$ _____ (the "Contract Sum") representing the Contractor's total bid.

7. Payment. The Owner shall pay the Contractor for the performance of the Work specified in this Agreement, and the Contractor shall accept as full payment for its performance of the Work, the sum of \$ _____ Dollars ("Contract Sum") representing the Contractor's total bid. The Owner shall make a single payment of the Contract Sum to the Contractor within thirty (30) days of full performance of the Agreement by the Contractor, except for Contractor's responsibility to correct nonconforming Work.

8. Compliance with Laws. Contractor agrees to furnish Owner with the following at Contractor's expense: (1) a performance bond in an amount equal to the Contract Sum; (2) a warranty or defect's bond in an amount equal to the Contract Sum for a period of one (1) year from the date of Substantial Completion of the Work; and (iii) the statutory payment bond, all as required by the Oklahoma Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974, as amended (the "Act"). Contractor shall comply with all city, county, state and federal laws applicable to the completion of the Work called for under the Contract Documents including, without limitation, the mandatory requirements of the Act. Contractor shall furnish, at Contractor's sole cost and expense, all permits and inspections required by state or local law.

9. Indemnification of Owner. Contractor will indemnify Owner against any and all liabilities, suits, claims or causes of action, including enforcement actions of federal, state or local authorities arising out of or resulting, directly or indirectly, out of Contractor's performance of the Work. Contractor will defend all such actions at its own expense and will satisfy any judgment, penalties or fines rendered against Contractor or Owner in any such action or proceeding.

10. Insurance. Contractor shall carry, and require any other contractor or subcontractor to carry, the following insurance, properly extended to cover and protect Owner, with an insurance company or companies acceptable to Owner:

a) Workers' compensation insurance on all employees engaged in performance of the Work, covering all liability for worker's compensation under the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

b) Comprehensive automobile and general liability insurance covering personal injury or death and property damage with per person limits of not less than \$2,000,000 and \$75,000, respectively, i.e., per person minimum amounts of \$2,000,000 with regard to personal injury/death, and \$75,000 with regard to property damage.

c) Contractor waives all rights against Owner and its agents, officers, directors and employees for recovery of damages to the extent these damages are covered by the insurance maintained pursuant to the Agreement.

d) Contractor shall furnish Owner with a certificate of insurance at the time of execution of the Contract. The Certificate shall provide Owner as an additional insured and include a clause to require the insurer to notify the Owner thirty (30) days in advance of any cancellation or change in insurance contracts. Said insurance shall cover claims for such length of time as said claims are permitted by law. All policies must contain a waiver of subrogation in favor of Owner and its employees.

11. Changes in the Work. Owner may direct Contractor to make additions, deletions or other revisions to the Work. Any change in the scope of the Work or in the Contract Time shall be authorized by a written change order or change directive which shall describe, in detail, the addition, deletion or other revision and any increase or decrease in the Contract Sum or the Contract Time. The Contractor shall make no additions, deletions or revisions to the Work except pursuant to a written change order or change directive executed by Owner.

12. Warranty. Contractor warrants that the Project will be free from defects in labor and workmanship for a period of one year following Substantial Completion and acceptance of the Project by the Owner (the "Warranty Period"). Contractor agrees to repair or replace, without charge to the Owner, any defects in materials or workmanship which occur in normal service during the Warranty Period.

13. Completion and Acceptance of the Work. Following Substantial Completion of the Work, Contractor and Owner shall make a joint inspection of the Project, noting any defects, deficiencies, omissions or other items in need of correction in a written "punch list". Contractor shall fully repair, replace, correct or complete all items shown on the punch list promptly as a condition for payment of the balance of the Contract Sum. Upon notice by the Contractor that the Project has been fully completed, Contractor and Owner shall make a final inspection of the Project. If the Project has been completed in a good and workmanlike manner, and in accordance with the Contract Documents, the Owner shall accept the Project and Contractor shall submit Contractor's final invoice to the Owner in the full amount of the Contract Sum. The Owner agrees to pay such invoice promptly and in accordance with its usual invoice payment procedures.

14. Contractor Default. If Contractor fails to complete the Work within the Contract Time, fails to pay any subcontractor or trade contractor for material or labor furnished on the Project, or shall otherwise breach any material covenant, obligation or provision of this Contract, Owner shall have the right to terminate this Contract upon seven days' written notice unless Contractor cures the default within the notice period.

15. Unforeseen Circumstances. The Contract Sum does not include any additional Work required by any concealed or unforeseen site conditions. If the Contractor discovers any concealed or unforeseen site conditions or any hazardous materials to be disposed of as a part of the Work, it shall immediately notify the Owner of same in writing, together with Contractor's good faith estimate of the additional cost, if any, to be incurred in connection with such Work. Contractor shall not incur, nor shall Contractor be reimbursed for any additional cost unless same has been approved by the Owner in writing.

16. No Waiver. The failure of either party to this Agreement to insist upon the performance of any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, or the waiver of any breach of any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, shall not be construed as thereafter waiving any such terms and conditions, but these shall continue and remain in full force and effect as if no such forbearance or waiver had occurred.

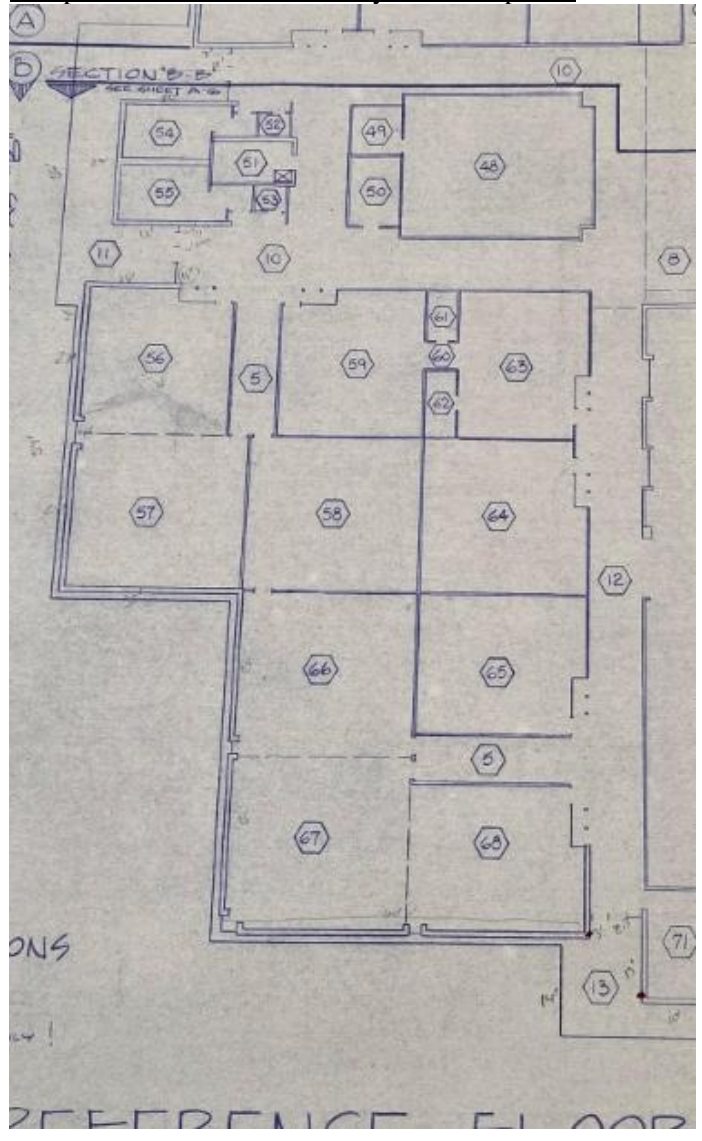
