Suggested Motion: That there shall be levied upon the taxable property of the St. Francis School District the sum of **\$8,881,382.00**. \$6,216,823.00 for the General Fund (the operation of the District schools); \$582,000.00 for the Community Service Fund; \$1,962,800.00 for the discharge of referendum debt obligations; and \$119,759.00 for the discharge of non-referendum debt obligations.
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- g. **School Board Salaries**
School Board salaries established by the electors of the St. Francis School District, Milwaukee County, State of Wisconsin are as follows: \$300.00 per month for the office of President; \$250.00 per month for the office(s) of Vice President, Treasurer, Clerk and Member.
 - h. **Payment of Actual and Necessary Expenses of School Board Members**
The electors also authorize for the payment of actual and necessary expenses of School Board Members when traveling in the performance of duties.
 - i. **Disposal of Surplus Property (Not Land or Buildings)**
The electors of the St. Francis School District, Milwaukee County, State of Wisconsin, authorize the School Board to dispose of surplus property (not land or buildings) that is no longer needed for school purposes upon terms and conditions satisfactory to the School Board.
 - j. **Date of 2027 Annual Meeting**
Suggested Motion: That the date of next year's Annual Meeting be Monday, September 27, 2027 at the St. Francis High School located at 4225 South Lake Drive in St. Francis, Wisconsin
 - k. **Other Discussion**
Electors attending the meeting may request information or be heard on any topic relative to current policies and procedures of the School District.

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ST. FRANCIS SCHOOL BOARD MEETING FORMAT

This meeting is a meeting of the Board of Education in public for the purpose of conducting the School District's business and is not to be considered a public community meeting. There is time of public participation during the meeting as indicated on the agenda.

The public is encouraged to attend board meetings to listen and observe. Visitors to School Board Meetings are required to sign in and may indicate they wish to address the Board.

Visitors requesting to speak will be allowed to do so, during the agenda item allowing for public comment. After being recognized by the Chair, individuals wishing to speak should state their name and address and proceed with a brief comment or question for clarification. Visitors must understand that the purpose of this meeting format is to invite audience commentary. It is not intended to initiate a dialog. The Board appreciates being made aware of information pertinent to agenda items.

Additionally, before any votes are taken, the Board President (Chairperson) may ask for any comments from the audience after:

- The Board has finished discussing the consent agenda.
- The Board has completed deliberation on any other action item.
- The Board has considered each discussion item.

State law prohibits the Board from discussing items not listed on the agenda. District policy requires that all meetings follow Robert's Rules of Order.
