REFUNDS

Tuition refunds are given for courses cancelled by Before and After Dark. Cancellation decisions will be made by (at least) one week before the class start date. A minimum number of students are required for a course to meet.

WITHDRAWALS

Students must withdraw at least one week prior to the scheduled class start date to receive a full tuition refund less a \$10 processing fee (per student/per class). After that time, tuition is committed to the course and no other refund will be granted. Activenet online transaction fees are non-refundable.

PICK UP

Class begin/end times are noted with each course description. Late fees will be assessed for children not picked up promptly from class. Children are not to be left unsupervised at any time.
