



Chad Sexton began his career as a teacher and athletic director and has more than 20 years in education. He holds a School Administrator Certificate with Central Office Endorsement from the Michigan Department of Education, a Master's degree from Central Michigan University, and is completing his Educational Specialist (Ed.S.) degree at Western Michigan University.
