

## SEDRO-WOOLLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT 2023-2024 School Board Goals & Expectations

1. **ACHIEVEMENT:** Prioritize student achievement and provide high quality instruction in every classroom, every day.
  - A. Increase graduation rates: 92% on time and 95% five-year.
  - B. 95% of grade 9 students earning sufficient credit (reduce course failure rates)
  - C. Increase student enrollment in college-level and dual credit courses.
  - D. Increase enrollment rates at post-secondary institutions and decreasing remediation rates in post-secondary training and education.
  - E. Increase student growth rates for grade 7 and 8, measured by iReady Testing.
  - F. Increase student growth rates for grades 4-6 measured by iReady Testing.
2. **Success For All:** Provide equitable educational access and opportunity to all students and families in a student-focused learning organization. Increasing the percentage of low income students enrollment in Honors and AP courses grades 7-12
  - A. 100% of eligible 8<sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in the College Bound Scholarship Program.
  - B. Increasing the percentage of MLL students in Honors and AP courses 7-12.
  - C. Increasing the percentage of MLL students exiting MLL within 5 years.
  - D. 70% of 12<sup>th</sup> grade students completing the FAFSA.
  - E. Decrease the number of repeated disciplinary suspension by students in grades 7-12.
  - F. Increase district-wide student attendance rates by reducing chronic absence.
  - G. Continue to support CTE pathways through the expansion of CTE course offerings and recognize these as a valid pathway for graduation and post-secondary success.

3. **STEWARDSHIP:** Ensure responsible allocation of resources to maximize student learning.
  - A. Sustain the undesignated fund balance at 4%-6%.
  - B. Continue upgrading district facilities.
  - C. Improve efficiencies in transportation, food service and custodial services.
  - D. Continue to develop a plan for maintenance and/or replacement of technology and safety resources supported by funds approved through the Technology and Safety Levy.
4. **PARTNERSHIPS:** Develop and sustain strong partnerships with our community in order to create a more unified learning environment for everyone.
  - A. Increase family engagement opportunities in all schools.
  - B. Provide opportunities for citizen participation and input.
  - C. Increase community partnerships in support of all schools.
5. **CONTINUOUS LEARNING:** Foster a community of life-long learners.
  - A. Develop an awareness of the benefits for life-long learning throughout the school community.
  - B. Develop and emphasize critical thinking, problem solving, communication and collaboration skills for all students.
