

EASTLAKE PARADE SAFETY RULES

Safety Rule # 1 – Maintaining a safe distance from the float in front is crucial **FOR ALL DRIVERS** (in trucks, cars, QUADS, etc.), without separating too far. Keep the flow of the parade going in a safe manner.

Safety Rule #2 – Participants on a float or pickup are required to keep all body parts, including legs, inside the vehicle or float to prevent unsafe conditions from arising.

Safety Rule #3 - Candy distribution to spectators shall occur by hand or soft toss. Do not throw candy or have spectators run towards the float.

Safety Rule #4 – When arriving at Eastlake High School to conclude the parade, please direct your vehicle or float to the mandatory drop-off area. Dropping off participants before parking is not permitted, as it may cause congestion for trailing floats on Emerald Park. Following this protocol is essential to guarantee prompt arrival at the community pep rally. Do not stop on Emerald Park for any reason. Proceed to the drop-off area.

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
