Weston School District Academic and Career Planning

Academic and Career Planning, or ACP, is a student-driven, adult and community-supported process in which students create and cultivate their own unique and information-based visions for post-secondary success, obtained through self-exploration, career exploration, and the development of career management and planning skills. The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction in the PI26 legislation requires public school districts to provide academic and career planning services to students in grades 6 through 12.

What is ACP?

Academic and Career Planning (ACP) is a 4-part process of Know, Explore, Plan, and Go which students develop throughout middle school and high school. At Weston School District, we are proud that we have implemented college and career planning with students and will continue to do so.

PI-26 is the legislation that requires Academic and Career Planning to take place in all public schools in the State of Wisconsin. Each school district must provide evidence of its implementation of PI-26.

To be college and career-ready, all students in grades 6-12 create an Academic & Career Plan. Students will have the opportunity to take coursework and gain experiences that align with their post-secondary plans. This also includes students with disabilities who have Individualized Education Programs (IEP)/Postsecondary Transition Plans (PTP), as well as students with Section 504 Accommodation Plans, English Language Learners, students who are Gifted and or Talented, students who are homeless, and students considered neglected and delinquent. These experiences will build credentials that have value for college admissions and future employment.
