Grading Guidelines

Elementary: 60% daily/40% test- Minimum of 10 Daily and 3 Test per 6 weeks

Secondary: 40% daily/60% test- Minimum of 10 Daily and 3 Test per 6 weeks

Progress Reports are a “snapshot” of grades at the end of the instructional day before they are given out. Progress reports can only help a student regain eligibility for UIL purposes, they can not hurt a student.
