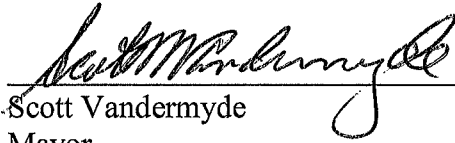

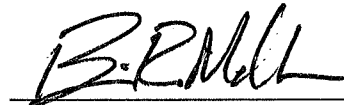
ADJOURNMENT
