CLEAR BAG POLICY

La Grange ISD will enforce a clear bag expectation at all campus and district events, similar to most professional, collegiate, and performance venues.

FIELD GUIDELINES

- Molded cleats or athletic shoes only on the field
- No sports drinks allowed on the field Water only
- No glass bottles or glass containers allowed on the field.
- No chairs allowed on the field without prior administrative approval
- No shelled nuts, seeds or gum on the field
- Keep trash and litter off the field.
- Mud and dirt tracking on the fields will be minimal.
- No sharp objects. No stakes. No corner flags allowed on the field.
- No bicycles, skates, skateboards, nor strollers allowed on the track or field.
- No painting, silly string, nor confetti.
- No Noise devices, including whistles, glass bottles/containers.
- All spirit debris must be removed upon completion of the competition.
- State Law: No Firearms, Drugs, Alcohol or Tobacco Products including vaping.


