

**PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUCEMENT
EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY FOR ALL CITY RESIDENTS.
WATER REGULATIONS, DAYS OF WATER USE FOR IRRIGATION**

The City of Salmon is reminding residents that City Code Title 5 (V), Chapter 51 Subsection 51.01 reads as follows.

§ 51.01 DAYS OF WATER USE FOR IRRIGATION

It shall be unlawful for any inhabitant, resident or water user of the city to cause or permit the use of municipal domestic water, for which the individual resident or water user is charged by the city for the use of the water, for irrigation and/or sprinkling except on the days set forth herein.

(A) *Even-numbered days.* All such water users so using this water on premises or property identified on the official map of the city with an address ending in an even number shall be permitted to so use this water on even-numbered calendar days.

(B) *Odd-numbered days.* All such water users so using this water on premises or property identified on the official map of the city with an address ending in an odd number shall be permitted to so use this water on odd-numbered calendar days.

(C) *Thirty-first day of month.* It shall be unlawful for any inhabitant, resident or water user to irrigate and/or sprinkle on the thirty-first (31st) day of any month.

If you are irrigating from an existing well please display an "Irrigated by Pump" sign.

Citations may be issued to those not in compliance with these regulations.

§ 51.99 PENALTY.

It shall be unlawful for any person to commit any act or fail to perform any requirement which is prohibited or required by this chapter, and the violation is hereby declared to be an **infraction** and is subject to penalty as provided in § 10.99 of the Salmon City Code.

Ordinance 25-873, Subsection § 10.99 Penalty

Infraction defined.

When this offense is designated as an infraction by any section or provision of this code or by state law, it is punishable only by a penalty not exceeding the fee set by resolution (currently \$300), no incarceration may be imposed.

When an offense is designated as an infraction by any section or provision of this code or by state law the second citation within a year for the same offense will be deemed a misdemeanor.
