

## **Public Media Release: Free and Reduced-Price School Meals**

School Year 2025–2026

Libertas Academy Boiling Springs announces its policy for providing free and reduced-price meals for students served under the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP).

Students from households meeting the Federal income eligibility guidelines for free or reduced-price meals are eligible for free or reduced-price meals. Children in households receiving benefits from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), or the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), and children who are foster, homeless, migrant, or runaway, are automatically eligible for free meals. Applications for free and reduced-price meals may be submitted at any time during the school year. For additional information, please contact:
