

**BOLTON-EDWARDS  
ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ZONE**

This attendance zone includes a common border with the Clinton Public School District. This shared border is defined by a Consent Decree dated March 21, 1980 and attached to these descriptions on the last two pages. Since this Consent decree does not follow exact section lines or roads, a general description of the outside perimeters of the Bolton-Edwards Elementary/Middle School Attendance Zone is outlined below:

- This attendance zone begins in the northwest corner of Hinds County and follows the March 21, 1980 Consent Decree boundary of the Clinton Public School District down to the vicinity of St. Thomas Road.
- Follows the western Clinton City Limits to St. Thomas Road (formerly Lancaster Road) and continues west along St. Thomas Road to its intersection with Airplane Road
- North on Airplane Road to the intersection of Raymond-Bolton Road
- South along Raymond-Bolton Road to Houston Road
- West on Houston Road to North Chapel Hill Road
- North on North Chapel Hill Road to Billy Fields Road
- West on Billy Fields Road to Champion Hill Road
- West on Champion Hill Road to Buck Reed Road
- South on Buck Reed Road to Highway 467
- East on Highway 467 to Military Road
- South on Military Road to Mt. Moriah Road
- West on Mt. Moriah Road to Bush Bottom Road
- South on Bush Bottom Road to Old Port Gibson Road
- Southwest on Old Port Gibson Road to Bill Strong Road
- West on Bill Strong Road to Canada Cross Road
- Northwest on Canada Cross Road to Gilmore Road
- Northwest on Gilmore Road to Newman Road
- West/southwest on Newman Road to Canada Cross Road
- West on Canada Cross Road to Highway 27
- West on Highway 27 to the western Hinds County line
- North along the western Hinds County line (Big Black River) to the northwest corner of Hinds County, which was the beginning point in this description.

Specific aspects of this attendance zone:

- This attendance zone includes those areas with exclusive access to the following roads: Champion Hill Road, Billy Fields Road, Houston Road, Raymond Bolton Road, St. Thomas Road (formerly Lancaster Road), Percy Davis Road, Kelly Drive, Bolton-Brownsville Road, and Cox's Ferry Road.
- Although Westview Subdivision on Northside Drive has a Bolton address, it is a part of the Clinton school zone. The streets in this subdivision include the following: Success Drive, Grand Avenue, Westview, and Broadway.
- Check tax rolls on all Bolton addresses, especially those on the western side of the attendance zone.

### **RAYMOND HIGH SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ZONE**

This zone shares a border with the Gary Road/Byram/Terry Attendance Zone. All roads that make up this border or have exclusive access to this border are part of the Gary Road/Byram/Terry Attendance Zone.

Below are the outside perimeters of the Raymond High School Attendance Zone:

- This attendance zone begins at the southwest corner of Hinds County
- Runs north along the western Hinds County Line to the northwest corner of Hinds County
- Continues from the northwest corner of Hinds County and follows the March 21, 1980 Consent Decree boundary of the Clinton Public School District down to the vicinity of St. Thomas Road.
- Follows the western Clinton City Limits to St. Thomas Road (formerly Lancaster Road) and continues west along St. Thomas Road to its intersection with Airplane Road
- Follows the western Clinton City Limits to the intersection of Smith Creek and Lockett Lane
- South along Springridge Road to Kimbell Road
- West along Kimbell Road to Flowers Road
- South along Flowers Road to Parsons Road
- West along Parsons Road to Dry Grove Road
- South along Dry Grove Road to the south Hinds County line
- Follow the south Hinds County line to the far southwest corner, which is the beginning point of this description.

Specific aspects of this attendance zone:

- Although Westview Subdivision on Northside Drive has a Bolton address, it is a part of the Clinton school zone. The streets in this subdivision include the following: Success Drive, Grand Avenue, Westview, and Broadway.
- South Norrell Road is in Clinton's school district, not HCS D. The only possible exceptions might be #3051 and #3129. As of April 2005, there were no houses on this portion of the road.
- Always check with the tax assessor on those areas that are near the Clinton school zone, such as Midway, Wells, Norrell, and McRaven. A property is a part of the school district that received the school taxes for that property.

**RAYMOND ELEMENTARY and CARVER MIDDLE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ZONE**

Below are the outside perimeters of the Raymond Elementary/Middle School Attendance Zone:

- This attendance zone begins at the point where Lebanon Pine Grove Road is intersected by Dry Grove Road
- Runs north along Dry Grove Road to Parsons Road
- Runs east along Parsons Road to Flowers Road
- North along Flowers Road to Kimbell Road
- East and northeast along Kimbell Road to Springridge Road
- North along Springridge Road to the intersection of Luckett Lane and Smith Creek
- Follows the southern and western Clinton City Limits to St. Thomas Road (formerly Lancaster Road) and continues west on St. Thomas Road to its intersection with Airplane Road
- North along Airplane Road to Raymond-Bolton Road
- South along Raymond-Bolton Road to Houston Road
- West on Houston Road to North Chapel Hill Road
- North on North Chapel Hill Road to Billy Fields Road
- Northwest on Billy Fields Road to Champion Hill Road
- West on Champion Hill Road to Buck Reed Road
- South on Buck Reed Road to Highway 467
- East on Highway 467 to Military Road
- South on Military Road to Mt. Moriah Road
- West on Mt. Moriah Road to Bush Bottom Road
- South on Bush Bottom Road to Old Port Gibson Road
- East on Old Port Gibson Road to Learned Road
- South on Learned Road to Lebanon Pine Grove Road
- Southeast on Lebanon Pine Grove Road to Dry Grove Road, which was the beginning point of this description

Specific aspects of this attendance zone:

- This attendance zone includes those areas with exclusive access to the following roads:
  - Bush Bottom Road
  - Mt. Moriah Road (between Bush Bottom Road and Military Road)
  - Military Road
  - Highway 467 (between Buck Reed Road and Military Road)
  - Buck Reed Road (between Highway 467 and Champion Hill Road)
- North and South Norrell Road are in Clinton's school district, not HCSD. The only possible exceptions might be #3051 and #3129.
- Areas with exclusive access to the bordering roads of this zone are a part of the other school attendance zone.
- Always check with the tax assessor on those areas that are near the Clinton school zone, such as Midway, Wells, Norrell, and McRaven. The property is a part of the school district that received the school taxes for that property.

**TERRY HIGH/GARY ROAD ELEMENTARY AND INTERMEDIATE/  
BYRAM MIDDLE ATTENDANCE ZONE**

Below are the outside perimeters of the Terry/Gary Road/Byram Attendance Zone:

- This attendance zone begins at the south Hinds County boundary at the point intersected by Dry Grove Road
- Runs north along Dry Grove Road to Parsons Road
- Runs east along Parsons Road to Flowers Road
- North along Flowers Road to Kimbell Road
- East and Northeast on Kimbell Road to Springridge Road
- North along Springridge Road to North McRaven Road and follows the Clinton city limits
- Follows the Jackson City Limits east and southeast to the Pearl River
- Follows the Pearl River south to the southeastern point of Hinds County
- West along the southern boundary of Hinds County to Dry Grove Road, which was the starting point of this description.

Specific aspects of this attendance zone:

- Areas with exclusive access to Dry Grove Road between the south Hinds County line and Parsons Road are included in this zone. (The fire station on Tank Road is located in this zone; areas west of the four way stop are in the Utica zone.) On Tank Road #8851 and below are a part of this attendance zone.
- Areas with exclusive access to Springridge Road are included in this zone. Examples: Falcon Ridge only has access only to Springridge Road; therefore is a part of this zone. Springwood Acres 3 and Indian Hills have access to Owens Road; therefore, they are not a part of this zone.
- Lake Mimosa is not part of this attendance zone because it has access to the western portion of McFarland Road.
- The first house on Terry Road after the “Begin Hinds County Maintenance” sign is #5167. All numbers below #5167 on Terry Road are in the JPS zone; all numbers beginning with 5167 and above are in this zone.
- On Sycamore Drive #5232 and higher are HCSD; #5227 starts JPS.
- On Western Hills Drive, #105-223 are JPS; the rest are HCSD.
- All areas along the north, western, and southern sides of this zone require a check with the Tax Assessor’s Office or the tax rolls to determine if the school taxes are paid to Clinton School District, Claiborne County School District, Jackson Public Schools, Copiah County School District, or HCSD. The school district to which taxes are paid is the final authority in determining in which school district a property is located.

## UTICA ATTENDANCE ZONE

Unless specified differently below, the borders of this attendance zone are not split with another attendance zone. The northern border roads and those with exclusive access to these roads are part of the Utica attendance zone. The northeast border roads and those with exclusive access to these roads are part of the Raymond Elementary and Carver Middle Attendance Zone. The eastern border roads and those with exclusive access to these roads are part of the Gary Road/Byram/Terry Attendance Zone.

Below are the outside perimeters of the Utica Attendance Zone:

- This attendance zone begins at the southwest corner of Hinds County
- Runs north along the western Hinds County line to its intersection with State Highway 27
- Goes east along State Highway 27 to its intersection with Canada Cross Road
- Goes east along Canada Cross Road to its intersection with Newman Road
- Goes in a northeastern direction along Newman Road to Gilmore Road
- Southeast along Canada Cross Road to its intersection with Middle Road
- Continue across Bill Strong Road to its intersection with Old Port Gibson Road
- Note that all of Middle Road and roads with exclusive access to Middle Road are included in this zone.
- Northeast along Old Port Gibson Road to Learned Road
- South along Learned Road to Lebanon Pine Grove Road
- Southeast along Lebanon Pine Grove Road to its intersection with Dry Grove Road
- South along Dry Grove Road to the south boundary of Hinds County
- West along the southern boundary of Hinds County to the point of beginning in the southwest corner of Hinds County

Specific aspects of this attendance zone:

- Those areas with exclusive access to a public road that is **one of the roads forming the most northerly line** of the Utica Attendance Zone (including areas along Dry Grove Road) are a part of the Utica Attendance Zone.
- Areas with exclusive access to Dry Grove Road are a part of the Terry High/Gary Road Elementary and Intermediate/Byram Middle Attendance Zone.
- On Tank Road house numbers #8990 and above are a part of the Utica Attendance Zone. Any number below #8990 would be the Terry/Gary Road/Byram Attendance Zone.
- **Always check with the Tax Assessor's Office or the tax rolls to determine if an address along the county line pays taxes to HCS D, Copiah County School District, or Claiborne County School District. This is the final authority on which school district the property is located in.**

## **Border Roads inside Hinds County School District**

Airplane Road. All of Airplane Road south of St. Thomas Road is in the Raymond Attendance Zone. As of April 20, 2005, there were no houses located on the small section of Airplane Road north of the intersection of St. Thomas Road to the intersection of Raymond Bolton Road. This small section is located in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

Canada Cross Road. All of Canada Cross Road is located in the Utica Attendance Zone.

Champion Hill Road. All of Champion Hill Road is in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

Bill Strong Road. All of Bill Strong Road is located in the Utica Attendance Zone.

Billy Fields Road. All of Billy Fields Road is in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

Buck Reed Road. All homes on Buck Reed Road with house number 3135 and above are in the Raymond Attendance Zone. Anyone living on Buck Reed Road north of Champion Hill Road with house number 1591 and below will attend Bolton-Edwards.

Bush Bottom Road. All of Bush Bottom Road is in the Raymond Attendance Zone.

Bush Road. All of Bush Road is in the Utica Attendance Zone. At the point that Bush Road turns to Pine Street, one lives in the Raymond Attendance Zone.

Deviney Drive. All of Deviney Drive is in the Terry Attendance Zone.

Dry Grove Road. The Raymond Attendance Zone on Dry Grove Road ends with house #8389 Dry Grove Road north of the intersection of Dry Grove Road and Parsons Road (Note: there is one additional unmarked house number just north of Parsons Road at this intersection). The Terry Attendance Zone begins on Dry Grove Road south of Parsons Road with house numbers 7675 and lower.

Gilmore Road. All of Gilmore Road is located in the Utica Attendance Zone.

Gonia Road. All of Gonia Road is located in the Raymond Attendance Zone because this road is only accessible by Lebanon-Pine Grove Road.

Highway 27. All houses on Highway 27 in Hinds County are in the Utica Attendance Zone. The first known house number in Warren County is 8350. All numbers lower than 8350 are in Warren County.

Highway 467. Houses on Highway 467 between the city of Raymond and house #2518 at the intersection of Hwy 467 and Buck Reed Road are in the Raymond Attendance Zone. The section of Highway 467 west of Buck Reed Road beginning with the Brandon Arms Apartments (601.852.2400) to the city of Edwards is located in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

Houston Road. All of Houston Road is in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

## HCSD attendance zone descriptions

Jacobs Drive. All of Jacobs Drive is located in the Raymond Attendance Zone because this road is only accessible by Military Road.

Kimbell Road. Kimbell Road is divided between the Raymond and Byram/Terry Attendance zones at Flowers Road. Homes on Kimbell Road that are west of Flowers Road (house numbers 3405 and lower) are in the Raymond Attendance Zone. Homes on Kimbell Road that are east of Flowers Road (house numbers 3517 and higher) are in the Byram/Terry Attendance Zone.

Kelly Drive. All of Kelly Drive is located in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

Learned. All addresses within the incorporated limits of Learned are in the Raymond Attendance Zone.

Learned Road. All of Learned Road is in the Raymond Attendance Zone.

Lebanon Pine Grove Road. The Raymond Attendance Zone on Lebanon Pine Grove Road begins with house #6846 Lebanon Pine Grove Road west of Dry Grove Road. The Terry Attendance Zone begins on Lebanon Pine Grove Road east of Dry Grove Road with house #7350 Lebanon Pine Grove Road.

Maddox Road. The odd house numbers between 1005-2699 are in the Byram/Terry Attendance Zone. The even house numbers between 2248-2694 are in Jackson Public School District. All house numbers beginning with 258 and lower are in the Jackson Public School District.

Middle Road. All of Middle Road is located in the Utica Attendance Zone.

Midway Road. All house numbers including 13088 and lower are in the Raymond Attendance Zone. House numbers above 13216 are in the Byram/Terry Attendance Zone.

Military Road. All of Military Road is in the Raymond Attendance Zone.

Moore Road. All of Moore Road is located in the Utica Attendance Zone because this road is only accessible by the section of Middle Road that is in the Utica Attendance Zone.

Mt. Moriah Road. The Raymond Attendance Zone begins at the intersection of Mt. Moriah and Old Port Gibson Road and ends with the Cherry Grove Missionary Baptist Church at 2840 Mt. Moriah Road. The Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone begins at the intersection of Mt. Moriah Road and Bush Bottom Road. The first house number west of this intersection is house#3491 Mt. Moriah Road. All subsequent house numbers above #3491 are in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

Natchez Trace Parkway. As of June 2005, there are no homes along the Natchez Trace Parkway nor are any listed on the tax rolls.

Newman Road. All of Newman Road between the intersection of Canada Cross Road and the intersection of Gilmore Road is located in the Utica Attendance Zone. This section includes house numbers 4600 and higher. All house numbers north of the intersection of Gilmore Road beginning with 4184 and lower are in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

## HCSD attendance zone descriptions

North Chapel Hill Road. The section of North Chapel Hill Road between Ratliff Road and Houston Road is located in the Raymond Attendance Zone. This section includes all house numbers 5362 and lower. All house numbers above #5362 are in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

North Midway Road. All house numbers 2606 and below are located in the Clinton Public School District. When there is a question, verify the status on the tax rolls.

Old Port Gibson Road. The Raymond Attendance Zone on Old Port Gibson Road ends with house #11800 just east of the intersection of Adams Station Road (to the south) / Bush Bottom Road (to the north) and Old Port Gibson Road. The Utica Attendance Zone begins with any house number lower than 11800.

Percy Davis Road. All of Percy Davis Road is located in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone.

Pine Grove Circle. All of Pine Grove Circle is located in the Raymond Attendance Zone because this road is only accessible by the portion of Lebanon-Pine Grove Road that is part of the Raymond Attendance Zone border.

Pine Street. All of Pine Street in Learned is in the Raymond Attendance Zone.

Ranger Road. All of Ranger Road is located in the Byram/Terry Attendance Zone since it is only accessible from Parsons Road, which is a border road for the Byram Terry Attendance Zone.

Raymond Bolton Road. The section of Raymond Bolton Road between the city of Raymond and the intersection of Houston Road is in the Raymond Attendance Zone. This section includes house numbers 4357 and lower. The next section of Raymond Bolton Road from this intersection north is located in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone. This section includes house numbers 4550 and higher.

St. Thomas Road (formerly known as Lancaster Road). All of St. Thomas Road (formerly known as Lancaster Road) is in the Bolton Edwards Attendance Zone. As of April 20, 2005, no students lived on this road.

Wells Road. All of Wells Road beginning with house numbers 1560 and above is in the Raymond Attendance Zone. House numbers 297 and below are in the Clinton Public School District. Always check the tax roll to verify.

## **Roads Bordering the Clinton Public School District**

Bolton-Brownsville Road. With the exception of a small section of this road (located north of the intersection of Jimmy Williams Road to just south of the Beulah Memorial Church), all addresses on this road are located in Hinds County School District. The last known house number in Hinds County School District is #7835. As of April 22, 2005, there were no houses located on the section of this road in the Clinton Public School District.

Clinton-Tinnin Road. With the exception of a small section of this road (located .4-mile west of the intersection with Cox's Ferry Road), all of Clinton-Tinnin Road is located in Clinton Public School District. As of April 22, 2005, there were no houses located on this .4-mile section of Clinton-Tinnin Road west of the intersection with Cox's Ferry Road. The last known house # located in Hinds County School District located on this road is #11950 just west of the intersection with Cox's Ferry Road.

Cox's Ferry Road. Most of Cox's Ferry Road is located in the Hinds County School District with the following exceptions:

1. There is a .1-mile section of this road beginning at the intersection of Clinton-Tinnin Road going west that is located in the Clinton Public School District. However, as of April 22, 2005, there were no houses located on this section of road.
2. #6510 is the only house between Richardson Road and Johnson Line Road. This address is located in the Clinton Public School District.
3. There is a section of this road north of Johnson Line Road that is located in the Clinton Public School District. However, as of April 22, 2005, there were no houses located on this section of road.
4. #7714 and 7724 are located at the intersection with East Cox's Ferry Road. These two addresses are located in the Hinds County School District.
5. There is a small portion of East Cox's Road that is located in Hinds County School District. However, as of April 22, 2005, there were no houses located on this section of road. The first house found on East Cox's Ferry Road was #2025. This address and higher are located in the Clinton Public School District.

East Cox's Ferry Road. There is a small portion of East Cox's Road that is located in Hinds County. However, as of April 22, 2005, there were no houses located on this section of road. The first house found on East Cox's Ferry Road was #2025. This address and higher are located in the Clinton Public School District.

Frank Hall Road. There is a small portion of this road that is located in Hinds County. However, as of April 22, 2005, there were no houses located on this section of road. Clinton Public School District includes house numbers 1435 and higher.

Norrell Road. All of North and South Norrell Road are in the Clinton School District.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 1, T7N, R1W, thence West along the North boundary line of Hinds County to the Southeast corner of Section 36, T3N, R3W, thence North to the Big Black River, thence southwesterly along the Big Black River to the western boundary of Section 14, T8N, R3W, thence South along the western boundary of Sections 14, 23, 26, and 35, T8N, R3W and Section 2, T7N, R3W to the Southwest corner of the North half of Section 2, T7N, R3W, thence East to the western boundary of Section 1, T7N, R3W, thence South to the Southwest corner of the North half of Section 12, T7N, R3W, thence East to the western boundary of Section 7, T7N, R2W, thence South along the western boundary of Sections 7 and 18, T7N, R2W to the Northwest corner of Section 19, T7N, R2W, thence East along the northern boundary of Sections 19 and 20, T7N, R2W to the Northwest corner of the East half of Section 20, T7N, R2W, thence South to the northern boundary of Section 29, T7N, R2W, thence West along the northern boundary of Section 29, T7N, R2W, to the Northwest corner of Section 29, T7N, R2W, thence South along the western boundary of Sections 29 and 32, T7N, R2W to the Northeast corner of Section 6, T6N, R2W, thence West along the northern boundary of Section 6, T6N, R2W to the Northwest corner of Section 6, T6N, R2W, thence South along the western boundary of Sections 6, 7 and 18, T6N, R2W to the Southwest corner of Section 18, T6N, R2W, thence East along the southern boundary of Sections 18, 17 and 16, T6N, R2W to the Northwest corner of Section 22, T6N, R2W, thence South along the western boundary of Section 22, T6N, R2W to the Northwest corner of Section 27, T6N, R2W, thence East to the Northwest corner of the East half of the West half of Section 27, T6N, R2W, thence South to the northern boundary of Section 34, T6N, R2W, thence West to the Northwest corner of Section 34, T6N, R2W, thence South along the western boundary of Section 34, T6N, R2W

to the Southwest corner of Section 34, T6N, R2W, thence East along the southern boundary of Section 34, T6N, R2W to its intersection with the Natchez Trace, thence northeasterly along the Natchez Trace and its proposed extension to U.S. Highway 49, thence North along the eastern boundary of Sections 11 and 2, T6N, R1W to the Southwest corner of Section 36, T7N, R1W, thence East to the Southeast corner of the West half of Section 36, T7N, R1W, thence North to the center of said Section 36, T7N, R1W, thence East to the Madison County line, thence North along the Madison County line to the point of beginning.
