CALL TO ORDER AND WELCOME

Mayor Boyd called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Councilwoman Gaitten led the Pledge of Allegiance.

INVOCATION

City Manager Scott Wood gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Councilwoman Kilcrease made a motion to approve the agenda. Councilman McKie seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilwoman Kilcrease made a motion to approve the following minutes:

- a) Regular Meeting, Monday, October 13, 2025, 5:30 p.m.

Councilman McKie seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

PRESENTATIONS

Frank D’Arcangelo – Revised Fire Station Plans

Mr. D’Arcangelo gave an update on the revised plans for the new fire station. The building is a little more than 13,000 sq. feet. It will be a two-story building with brick on two sides (Lewis Street and Vertia Street). The NAPA side will be concrete and the back metal. Mr. Wood informed council that the project is within budget, and we should be able to start after the first of the year. We are currently working on the bonding.

Jana Sasser - City Manager Hiring Process, Zoning and Zoning Ordinance Update, and DRIs and Development Impact Analysis

Mrs. Jana Sasser addressed council regarding the following:

1. The Candler County Commission gave the citizens opportunity to participate in the hiring of the county manager. She asked the council to do the same during the hiring process of the city manager. She asked them to consider having a meet and greet so that the public could ask questions.
2. We need updates on the zoning in general and the proposed new zoning ordinance. Ms. Concannon said that the city can schedule open house sessions.

Ms. Concannon said that it has not been discussed with the Planning Commission at this time. Mrs. Sasser reminded the council that the ordinance has been drafted since November 12th of last year and she thought it would be more of a priority. Mayor Boyd agreed that public meetings and workshops need to be scheduled.

3. Mrs. Sasser discussed the Central Station Development. She said that she assumes that the response to the county is the response to the citizens. She also assumed that the strategies listed are the overall strategies. Do we know what is required to support that growth? Have we performed any financial metric exercises?

Councilwoman Taylor said that council would review with the city attorney regarding citizen participation with the hiring process. She said there could be a conflict for applicants that are still working. Councilwoman Gaitten stated that the top three candidates can be made public.

Councilwoman Taylor said that the updating of the zoning is one of her priorities. She also commented that the DRI looks at all the data. Two housing studies have been done.

NEW BUSINESS

Bid Approval Metter Ford

Councilwoman Kilcrease made a motion to approve a bid from Metter Ford in the amount of Fifty-six thousand, five hundred fifty-eight dollars and fourteen cents (\$56,558.14) for the purchase of a 2026 Ford F150 for the Metter Police Department. Councilman McKie seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

This purchase is included in the FY 26 General Fund budget. It will be a GMA lease purchase. Lease payments will be included in the FY 27 budget using funds from the General Fund operating budget.

Bid Approval Metter Ford

Councilman McKie made a motion to approve a bid from Metter Ford in the amount of fifty-nine thousand, four hundred, forty dollars and fourteen cents (\$59,440.14) for the purchase of a 2026 Ford Explorer for the Metter Police Department. Councilwoman Kilcrease seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

At a recent Chiefs training, Chief Lewis won an emergency equipment package that will be used for this purchase. The GBI has agreed to pay for the remaining cost to purchase and have the emergency equipment installed. The total net cost to the city for this purchase will be forty-six thousand, five hundred, thirty-five dollars. (\$46,535.00). This purchase is included in the FY 26 General Fund budget. It will be a GMA lease purchase.

Lease payments will be included in the FY 27 budget using funds from the General Fund operating budget.

Resolution Amending the 2025 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget

Councilman McKie made a motion to approve a Resolution to adopt the first amendment to 2025 Fiscal Year Budget for the General Fund of the City of Metter, Georgia; appropriating the amounts shown in each budget as expenditures/expenses; adopting the several items of revenue anticipations; prohibiting expenditures or expenses from exceeding the actual funding appropriated. Councilwoman Taylor seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

Resolution Amending the 2026 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget

Councilwoman Kilcrease made a motion to approve a Resolution to adopt the first amendment to the 2026 Fiscal Year Budget for the General Fund of the City of Metter, Georgia; appropriating the amounts shown in each budget as expenditures/ expenses; adopting the several items of revenue anticipations; prohibiting expenditures or expenses from exceeding the actual funding appropriated. Councilman McKie seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

Language Access Plan

Councilwoman Kilcrease made a motion to adopt an updated Language Access Plan for the City of Metter, Georgia Community Improvement Department October 2025 to satisfy special condition #1 for the Georgia Department of Community Affairs Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Project No. 25p-x-021-2-6800. Councilman McKie seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

Special Event Alcohol Permit

Councilman McKie made a motion to approve a Special Event Alcohol Permit Application applied for by Timothy Coleman for Burlap and Lace Market and Coffee Bar located at 10 N. Lewis Street for a paint party on Thursday, November 13, 2025. Councilwoman Kilcrease seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

OTHER BUSINESS FROM COUNCIL

Councilwoman Gaitten had concerns regarding the following:

1. Animal Shelter policies and procedures. There are no set timelines for keeping animals. She said that she asked for a copy of the policies and procedures. Also, staff have asked for updates. Do we need a workshop on this? Council agreed for animal shelter staff and Chief Lewis to present their updates for council to review.

2. Asking the Sheriff's office to give us the presentation that community members have seen. Councilwoman Gaitten said that she thinks city council should see what was presented to the community.
3. The Homestead exception council has already approved in previous months but later found out that it needed to be approved by Georgia House of Representatives. She said that council voted on this back in 2024. City Attorney Brent Carter said that it will have to go before the General Assembly, and they are not in session right now. He said that he has been in contact with Billy Hickman regarding this issue.
4. Status on our Economic Development. Councilwoman Gaitten asked if we are going without a director and are we paying Jasmine Sandifer for her extra responsibilities?
5. Alcohol Ordinance updating. This is regarding selling alcohol in to-go cups. Councilwoman Kilcrease said that she looked on the state website and there are a lot of regulations. Councilman Stewart said that it has already been approved by the state. Council agreed to place this on the next agenda.
6. Presenting our hiring process to the community for the City Manager position.
7. The recent DRI and future planning. Councilwoman Gaitten said that she has similar questions regarding this matter as Mrs. Sasser. There are more houses on this development than the other one. We need to schedule a workshop on this.
8. Discussion about Public Works moving forward with the retirement of the department head. How are we moving forward with Cliff Hendrix's retirement? What is the status on the pond dam? Mr. Wood stated that the pond dam repairs are scheduled for mid-December.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Written reports were placed in the agenda packets for council to review.

CITY MANGER'S REPORT

Mr. Wood reported that James McCray will serve as Acting Public Works Director upon Mr. Hendrix's retirement on November 27, 2025. Mr. McCray has been with the city for eighteen ½ years.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Boyd congratulated Councilwoman Taylor on winning the election for mayor and the two new council people. He thanked Mrs. Sasser for her concerns and point of view.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilwoman Kilcrease made a motion to go into executive session regarding personnel, pursuant to O.C.G.A. 50-14-2(1) at 6:35 p.m. Councilwoman Taylor seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

Official Code of Georgia Annotated TITLE 3 Alcoholic Beverages (Chs. 1 – 15) CHAPTER 3 Regulation of Alcoholic Beverages Generally (Arts. 1 – 3) Article 1 General Provisions
(§§ 3-3-1 – 3-3-11)

3-3-11. Sale of mixed drinks for off premises consumption.

(a) For purposes of this Code section, the term:

(1) "Approved container" means a tamper evident container that:

(A) Does not contain openings or straw holes;

(B) Is sealed in a manner that is visibly apparent if the container has been subsequently opened or tampered with; and

(C) Has an affixed label or marking that identifies the licensee that prepared and sold the mixed drink.

(2) "Curbside pick-up" means when a licensee furnishes purchased goods to a customer's vehicle within a clearly designated pick-up area located within a paved parking area adjacent to the licensed premises.

(3) "Food service establishment" means any establishment holding a valid food service permit from its respective county health department.

(4) "Mixed drink" means a beverage prepared by combining distilled spirits with nonalcoholic liquid or liquids and that:

(A) Is prepared on the day of sale by an employee of the licensee;

(B) Contains no more than 3 ounces of distilled spirits; and

(C) Is sealed in an approved container.

(b) Notwithstanding any other contrary provision of law and unless otherwise prohibited by local ordinance or resolution, any food service establishment which is licensed to sell distilled spirits for consumption on the premises may sell mixed drinks for off-premises consumption in approved

containers, provided that such mixed drinks are:

(1) Sold to an individual 21 years of age or older who shall be limited to two mixed drinks per entree ordered;

(2) Accompanied by a food order and a sales receipt with a time stamp that indicates the date and time of such purchases;

(3) Sold for personal use and not for resale and picked up in person by the same individual customer to whom the mixed drinks and entrees were sold and from whom the food service establishment received payment; provided, however, that such individual customer shall not include a delivery service or third-party agent; and

(4) Furnished with the accompanying food order to the customer on the premises or by way of curbside pick-up.

(c) If transported in a motor vehicle, the customer shall place the mixed drink in a locked glove compartment, a locked trunk, or the area behind the last upright seat of a motor vehicle that is not equipped with a trunk.

(d) Sales of mixed drinks for off-premises consumption shall be taxed in accordance with Code Sections 3-4-130 through 3-4-133.

(e) The commissioner shall promulgate and enforce such rules and regulations as he or she may deem reasonable and necessary to effectuate the provisions of this Code section.

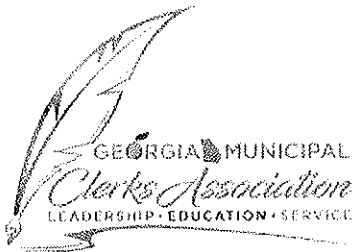

BY-LAWS FOR THE METTER-CANDLER COUNTY
AIRPORT AUTHORITY

ARTICLE I

Section 1. Title and purpose. This body shall be known as the Metter-Candler County Airport Authority and will hereinafter be referred to as the "Authority". Its purpose shall be to perform those purposes and objectives as set forth in Ga. L. 1986, p. 4638 (House Bill No. 1880).

Section 2. By-Laws. These By-Laws and any future amendments hereto, shall be adopted by the affirmative vote of the Metter-Candler County Airport Authority. Notice of a proposed amendment, including the general description of the same, shall be included in the agenda for any meeting at which an amendment is proposed.

Section 3. Definitions. As used herein, unless the context in which they are used requires otherwise, the following terms shall have the following meanings.

(a) The term "airport" means:

(1) Any area of land or water or any structure which is or has been used, or which the authority may plan to use for the landing and taking off of commercial, private, and military aircraft, including helicopter, and all building, equipment, facilities, or other property and improvement of any kind or nature located within the bounds of any such land or water area structure;

(2) Facilities of any type for the accommodation of passengers, maintenance, servicing, and operation of aircraft, business offices and facilities of private businesses and governmental agencies, parking of automobiles, and all other activities which are or have been carried on or which may be necessary or convenient in conjunction with the land and taking off of commercial, private, and military aircraft; and

(3) All buildings, equipment, facilities, and other property and improvements of any kind or nature located outside the bounds of any such land or water area or structure which is or has been used or which the authority plans to use for the landing and taking off of commercial, private, and military aircraft which are necessary for the safe operation of aircraft, including without limitation aviation easements and other real or personal property.

(b) The term "city" means the City of Metter.

(c) The term "county" means Candler County.

Article II

Section 1. Members of the Authority. The authority shall be composed of six posts numbered 1 through 6. The governing authority of the City of Metter shall appoint three members of the authority to represent Post 1, 3, and 5. The governing authority of Candler County shall appoint three members of the authority to represent Posts 2, 4, and 6.

Section 2. Terms. The initial terms of members of the authority shall be as follows:

Post No. 1 ending December 31, 1986.

Post No. 2 ending December 31, 1987.

Post No. 3 ending December 31, 1988.

Post No. 4 ending December 31, 1989.

Post No. 5 ending December 31, 1990.

Post No. 6 ending December 31, 1991.

Thereafter all members shall be appointed for terms of six years each and until their successors are appointed. Members of the authority shall be eligible for reappointment.

Section 3. Election of officers. After the appointment of all members, the full membership of the authority shall meet as soon as practicable and shall elect one of its members as chairman and one as vice-chairman, each of whom shall serve in such positions until the first meeting in January of the succeeding year and until their successors are elected. Thereafter, a chairman and a vice-chairman shall be elected in the same manner in January of each year to serve for the succeeding year and until their successors are elected. The chairman and vice-chairman when acting as chairman shall not be entitled to vote on matters before the authority except in the case of a tie vote. The chairman shall preside at the meetings of the authority and the vice-chairman shall preside in his absence, and they shall have such other powers, duties, and responsibilities as are set out elsewhere in this Act and in the bylaws of the authority. The authority shall also designate a secretary to keep the minutes and records of the authority. The authority shall appoint a treasurer who shall have custody of all moneys, funds, notes, bonds, and other securities as the authority may prescribe. Under the supervision of the authority, the treasurer shall be responsible for the day-to-day financial obligations and for such other duties as may be prescribed by the authority.

Section 4. Quorum. A majority of the members of the authority shall constitute a quorum and shall consist of at least four members. A majority of the quorum may exercise any and all powers of the authority.

Section 5. Meetings. The authority shall meet at least once a quarter and at such other times as it may deem necessary. Meetings will take place on the first Tuesday of each month beginning at 5:00 p.m. at Metter City Hall, 49 South Rountree Street, Metter, Georgia. Meeting dates and times are subject to change by affirmative vote of the members.

Section 6. Notice of meetings. Regular monthly meetings of the Authority may be held without notice if the date, time, and place of the meeting have previously been fixed by the authority; otherwise, regular meetings must be preceded by at least two days' notice to each member of the date, time, and place, but not the purpose of the meeting. Notice required by the foregoing provisions may be given by any usual means of communication and may be oral or written. Notice of all meetings of the authority must be given to the local media in order to fully comply with the provisions of Georgia's Open Meetings Act, codified at O.C.G.A. § 50-14-1, *et seq.*

Section 7. Compensation of members. The members shall receive no compensation but shall be reimbursed from the funds of the authority for reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in pursuing the business of the authority.

Section 8. Vacancies in Authority. Should an appointed member vacate his office either by resignation, death, change of residence, or removal or for any other reason, the governing authority of the city or county shall, as soon as practicable, appoint another member as a member of the authority to complete the unexpired term.

Section 9. Removal of members. Any member may be removed from office for good cause affecting his ability to perform his duties as a member, for misfeasance, malfeasance, or nonfeasance in office, by vote of three of the other members but only after a public hearing at which such member is given the rights to present evidence in his own behalf and only upon a finding by three of the other members that good cause for removal affecting the member's ability to perform his duties as a member exists, that he was guilty of misfeasance, malfeasance, or nonfeasance in office.

Section 10. Publication of financial report and budget. The authority shall, at least annually, publish, in the legal organ of Candler County, a statement of sources and expenditures of funds for the previous year and the proposed budget for the following year.

SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSULTANT
FOR
CITY OF METTER, GEORGIA

This agreement is entered into this _____ day of _____, 2025 by the City of Metter, Georgia by and through the Mayor and City Council, (hereinafter "City") to enter into the following Service Agreement for Public Works Consultant of City of Metter (hereinafter "Agreement") with GC Hendrix Consulting, LLC. of 245 Greenwood Drive, Metter, Georgia 30439 (hereinafter "Cliff") to provide services as Consultant for Public Works only for the City of Metter. The parties hereby agree to bind themselves to the following terms:

1. **Public Works Consultant Position.** The duties of the office of the consultant shall include, but will not be limited to, all duties found within the Charter, Code of Ordinances, and Personnel Manual & Policies of the City of Metter. The Public Works consultant will serve at the behest of the Mayor and City Council and City Manager and will take on any additional duties as prescribed by the same. By this agreement, Cliff Hendrix has been retained to fulfill this position as an independent contractor.
2. **Compensation.** The city agrees to pay Cliff \$4,800.00 monthly, the same representing 20 hours per week for Public Works consulting only. Any additional hours for Public Works consulting will be billed at \$90.00 per hour. Any additional duties may require additional payment. Payments under this agreement will be paid to contractor in monthly installments. In addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law, if City fails to pay for services when due, Cliff has the option to treat such failure to pay as a material breach of this Agreement and may cancel this Agreement and/or seek legal remedy.
3. **Term.** Beginning on a date to be set by the Mayor and Council, Cliff will provide the city service as Public Works Consultant. The term of this Agreement shall be for a period, of one year from the date of execution.
4. **Termination.**
 - (a.) This Agreement may be terminated by either party by providing a written notice 60 business days prior to termination. Cliff shall be entitled to compensation for the final 60 days of service under this Agreement. Cliff's failure to provide sufficient notice shall result in forfeiture of final payment for the 60-day period.
 - (b.) This Agreement shall terminate upon the insolvency or bankruptcy of either party.
 - (c.) By execution of this Agreement, Cliff its employees, agents and representatives waive any entitlement to additional compensation available upon removal or termination.

5. **Warranty.** Cliff shall provide its services and meet its obligations under this Agreement in a timely and workman like manner, using knowledge and recommendations for performing the service which meet generally acceptable standards in Cliff's community and region, and will provide a standard of care equal to, or superior to, care in the industry.
6. **Confidentiality.** Cliff and its employees, agents, or representatives will not at any time or in any manner, either directly or indirectly, use for the personal benefit of Cliff, or divulge, disclose, or communicate in any manner any information that is proprietary to the City. Cliff and its employees, agents, and representatives will protect such information and treat it as strictly confidential. This provision will continue to be effective after the termination of the Agreement. Any oral or written waiver by City of these confidentiality obligations which allows Cliff to disclose City's confidential information to a third party will be limited to a single occurrence tied to the specific information disclosed to the specific third party, and the confidentiality clause will continue to be in effect for all other occurrences. Upon termination of this Agreement, Cliff will return to the City all records, notes, documentation, and other items that were used, created, or controlled by Cliff during the term of the Agreement.
7. **Force Majeure.** If performance of this Agreement or any obligations under this Agreement is prevented, restricted, or interfered with by cause beyond either party's reasonable control (Force Majeure), and if the party unable to carry out its obligations gives the other party prompt written notice of such event, then the obligations of the party invoking this provision shall be suspended to the extent necessary by such event. The term Force Majeure shall include, without limitation, acts of God, fire, explosion, vandalism, storm, or other similar occurrence, orders or acts of military or civil authority, or by national emergencies, insurrections, riots, or wars, or strikes, lockouts, work stoppages. The excused party shall use reasonable efforts under the circumstances to avoid or remove such causes of non-performance and shall proceed to perform with reasonable dispatch whenever such causes are removed or ceased. An act or omission shall be deemed within the reasonable control of a party if committed, omitted, or caused by such party, or its employees, officers, agents, or affiliates.
8. **Notice.** Any notice to be provided to the parties in accordance with the terms of this Agreement may be made as follows:
 - (a.) Notice to city may be provided by placing the same in the care of the U.S. Postal Service addressed to City Manager, P.O. Box 74, Metter, Georgia 30439 or by hand delivery to City Manager, 49 South Rountree Street.

- (b.) Notice to Cliff may be provided by placing the same in the care of the U.S. Postal Service addressed to GC Hendrix Consulting, LLC, 245 Greenwood Drive, Metter, Georgia 30439, by hand delivery to Cliff Hendrix, or by email to the following email address: pchendrix@pineland.net.

9. Miscellaneous Provisions.

- (a.) If any provision of this Agreement is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction in Candler County, is held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions will continue to be valid and enforceable. If a court finds that any provisions of this Agreement are invalid or unenforceable, but that by limiting such provision it would become valid and enforceable, then such provision will be deemed to be written, construed, and enforced as so limited.
- (b.) This Agreement may be modified or amended in writing by mutual agreement between the parties, if the writing is signed by the party obligated under the amendment.

REIMBURSEMENT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Metter (the "Mayor and Council"), the governing body of the City of Metter, Georgia (the "City"), has determined that the acquisition, construction, and equipping of a new fire station (the "Project"), is necessary and desirable for the benefit of the City; and

WHEREAS, prior to the obtaining of a tax-exempt financing to pay all or a portion of the costs of the Project, the City reasonably expects to expend funds on the Project, which funds may be reimbursed from the proceeds of such tax-exempt financing for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City, pursuant to this resolution wishes to declare its official intent to reimburse from tax-exempt proceeds capital expenditures for the Project in the maximum amount of \$4,700,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council as follows:

1. The City reasonably expects to reimburse planned expenditures for the Project with proceeds of a tax-exempt financing.

2. The City hereby expresses its declaration of official intent, pursuant to Treasury Regulations § 1.150-2(d), to reimburse original expenditures on the Project in the maximum principal amount of \$4,700,000 with proceeds from a tax-exempt financing (to the extent permitted by § 1.150-2 of the Treasury Regulations). The City will pay original expenditures on the Project from a construction or other account maintained by the City.

3. The City shall make its reimbursement allocations not later than 18 months after the later of (i) the date the original expenditure is paid or (ii) the date the Project is placed in service or abandoned, but in no event more than three years after the original expenditure is paid.

4. This resolution shall become effective on the date of its adoption.
