SUMMER EBT

Nebraska will be participating in Summer EBT for Summer 2026! Eligible children will automatically receive an EBT card loaded with \$120 (\$40 per summer month) that families can use to purchase food at local retailers. SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM (SFSP)

The USDA's Summer Food Service Program provides no-cost meals to children ages 1-18 years at approved locations across the state.
