Freedom of Information Act

In compliance with State Law 5 ILCS 140/4, each school district is required to post specific information regarding the district as part of FOIA requirements on its website. If the information you are seeking is not found on the district website, you may request inspection and/or copies of existing documents. The request must be given in writing. Requests may be given in person at Harrison School District 36 District Office at 6809 McCullom Lake Rd in Wonder Lake, 60097 or sent to the district FOIA officer, Dr. Susan Wings via email at swings@hsd36.org.

When a request for information is received, the district must comply within five working days. Under certain circumstances, the response time may be extended for up to five additional working days. If this happens, you will be notified by letter at the end of the first five days specifying the reason for the delay. The fundamental right guaranteed by the Act is the right of inspection. While you may obtain copies of records requests, you are not required to purchase copies of records in order to gain access to them. When copies are requested, a public body may charge fees reasonably calculated to reimburse it for the actual cost of reproducing and certifying public records.

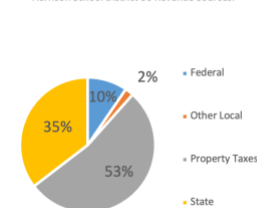
Our Finances

FY2024 Budget – \$7,850,010

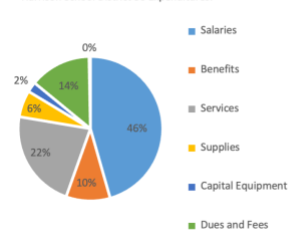
FY2023 Operating Expenditure per Pupil - \$15,133.06
