2. Discussion and Action to Approve/Deny Acceptance of the ACJC Criminal Justice Commission Grant Award for \$109,780.46 for the Purchase and Installation of Cameras at Western Park

Michael Bailey, Chief of Police

Chief of Police Michael Bailey respectfully requests the Vice Mayor and Council to accept the awarded funding from the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission (ACJC) for \$109,780.46 and assign the Town Manager as the Authorized Official for signing purposes. These funds will be used to purchase and install security surveillance cameras at Western Park. This project was started recently following shootings that occurred in that location. This is a reimbursable grant through ACJC with no match requirements. Council Member Genc requested some additional information about the grant. Chief Bailey provided that information. Council Member DeLeon asked if the information recorded by the cameras had the same policy regarding public access as body cameras. Chief Bailey replied that it would fall under the Policy the Town has regarding public requests for recorded time.

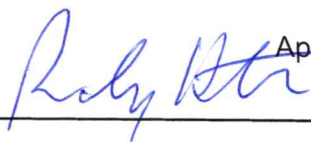
