Mayor Hartless and the Council Members were provided with a copy of the 2027 Proposed Tentative Budget for review and discussion during the work session. The budget is presented to council for consideration and input before the proposed budget is adopted in May 2026. The key factors considered in preparing the 2027 tentative proposed budget to move closer to building a

balanced budget to fund balance into the future, account for known/potential revenue loss, Town Infrastructure needs, highest quality public service to constituents, grant assistance, reward employees through compensation, and create Policies & Procedures for FY 2027 and into the future. The Town of Parker will see a reduction in its share of State Shared Revenues. Discussions on Net Position Challenges, Total Budgeted Revenues & Expenditures by Fund, by Type, by Debt, and Capital Projects Priority were reviewed. The Water Revenues & Operating Expenditures, and Water Contingency & Capital were discussed.
