Discussion and possible action on the following item(s)

Discussion and Action regarding the Joint Venture sewer system, including financial obligations, operational and administrative matters relating to the system, and the application of Joint Venture's moratorium on the Town and Tribe due to the current sewer system issues. The Council may vote to discuss this matter in Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A)(3), (4), and (6) for legal advice and to provide direction to the Town Manager and Town Attorney relating to negotiations with the Tribe, Joint Venture, or other funding entities.
