Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, February 4, 2020, at 6:00 P.M.

The Plainview Parks & Trails Commission meeting was called to order at 6 pm on February 4, 2020.

Commissioners in attendance: Aaron Luckstein, Jenny Schneider, Beau Hebert, Jason Hall, Marlene Young, and Carolyn Stelling. Absent: Ben Jacobs. Staff in attendance: Shane Loftus. Judith Jordan from the Plainview EDA was also in attendance.

Motion was made by Hebert and seconded by Hall to amend the agenda to move topics B and C under New Business to the end of the meeting. Passed 6/0.

Motion was made by Schneider and seconded by Hebert to approve the agenda as amended. Passed 6/0.

Motion was made by Hebert and seconded by Hall to approve the December 2019 meeting minutes. Passed 6/0.

Motion was made by Hebert and seconded by Schneider to approve the January 2020 meeting minutes. Passed 6/0.

Luckstein welcomed Stelling to the commission.

Motion was made by Young and seconded by Stelling to approve the proposed mission statement. Passed 6/0.

Schneider discussed the need for volunteers to supervise kids using the ice rink.

Schneider discussed the Rock on Ice fundraiser to potentially be held on February 15th. Schneider will work on organizing the fundraiser and Loftus will work on having the ice rink ready.

Loftus asked for feedback on Christmas decor for the new streetlights on Broadway. The plan is to have lighted decor on the 30-foot poles on the corners and for garland and bows on the shorter poles in between.

Jordan provided information on available grants. She offered to assist in writing grants the commission wishes to pursue.

Jordan provided an update on the MnDOT grants for landscaping. A grant was used in 2018 to do the landscaping across from KBS on Highway 42. The plan is to do landscaping near Lakeside on Highway 247 in 2020.
