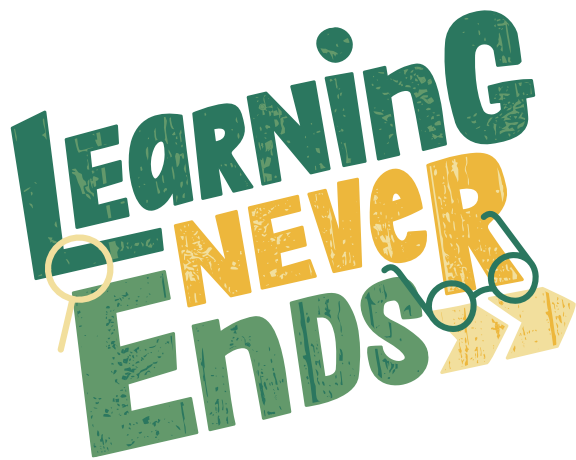
## Call For Adult Education Instructors for ECE!

This Spring the Ennis Continuing Education Program (ECE) has been encouraging learning and growth by holding 5 weekly classes, 6 workshops, as well as touring the Vintage Attic by Madison Valley Woman's Club and the Madison Dam with Northwestern Energy. One day workshops on Backyard Composting and Tree Pruning/Tree Planting were taught by our county MSU Ext. Agent, and Water Bath Canning was very popular with novice and advanced gardeners.

Instructors in the ECE Spring Session have introduced students to Kintsugi art on paper, led students on how to build a clay mug, and highlighted the beauty of beginning watercolor. Weekly classes led by instructors included exercise classes with Pound, Zumba, and Vinyasa Yoga; Open Sew and Welding were also offered as hands-on creative learning. This Spring session expanded the reach of ECE to many participants across the county seeing 147 participants in a short six weeks.

**Over the course of the year a total of 407 adult participants have engaged in classes, workshops, and tours through the Ennis Continuing Education Program (ECE). Whether it's been through Pickleball or Yoga in the Fall, Self Defense or Sewing in the Winter, Needle Felting or Welding in Spring; the ECE program has offered a plethora of ongoing education utilizing the School Building outside of the traditional School Day for adults in our community. If you haven't participated in the program yet, consider joining a class this Fall. If you're planning on taking a workshop in the next session when the schedule is announced at the end of August, invite a neighbor or friend to join and learn together. Continuing Education classes and workshops are open to all participants over the age of 17+ that are not currently enrolled in a public school. This extends beyond Ennis also, if your willing to drive over we would be delighted to have you participate!**

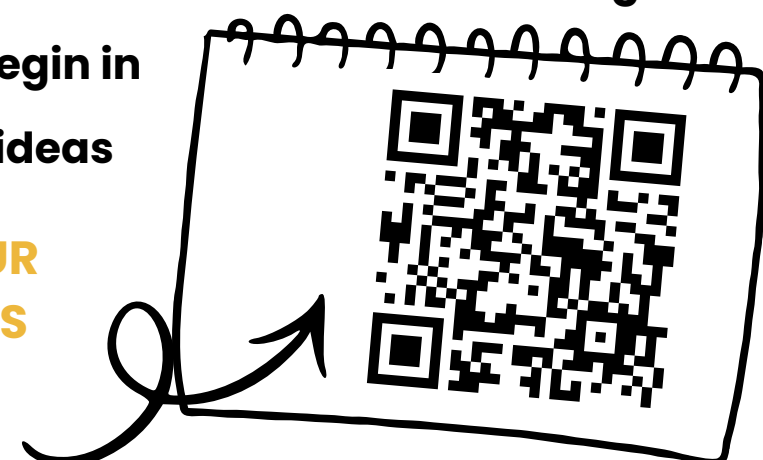

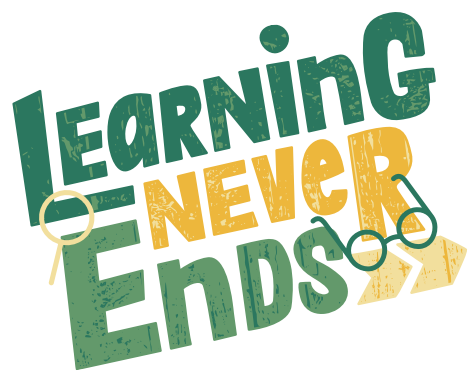
## Note from the Director
