PUBLIC HEARING# 1

This is a public hearing to solicit public input on community needs and priorities for housing, public facilities, and economic development. At this public hearing, the Town of Andrews will provide the results of its needs assessment and the activities that might be undertaken to meet identified needs, including the estimated amount proposed to be used for activities that will benefit persons of low and moderate income.

PUBLIC HEARING# 2

This is a public hearing concerning program performance and accomplishments conducted under a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project known as CDBG Project# 4-CI-21-001, N. Beech Avenue Water Upgrade wherein the following activities were undertaken:

The low and moderate income (LMI) national objective was met as this project upgraded the waterline along Beech Avenue from W. Main Street to W. Walnut Street from a 2 inch line to a 6" C900 PVC line. New ties to existing connections were made to create looping in the system as well as new service connections along the entire upgrade. The CDBG grant was awarded in the amount of \$469,876. There was also a local match/leveraging in the amount of \$121,776 which was provided by the Town of Andrews. The beneficiaries of the project, based upon income surveys, are 181 people, of whom 75.69% (137) are low to moderate income.
