 - b) Discuss and take appropriate action to consider request from JR Assets LLC to replat Blks 97, 98, 99 to the west and Blks 78,79, 80 to the east of North Guadalupe St. / Blks 79 and 98 to the south and Blks 78 and 99 to the north of West Blackjack St. / Blks 80 and 97 to the south of West Bois D’ Arc St. / Blks 79 and 98 to the north of West Bois D’ Arc.
5. Approve or disapprove the Planning & Zoning Commission’s recommendations:

 - b) Replat – JR Assets LLC
