

REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

The Edna City Council in regular session on Thursday, October 20, 2022, in Council Chambers at 6:00 p.m.

City Manager Gary Broz stated that he had spoken to Leighton Smith and Smith would like to be reconsidered for reappointment. Broz noted that he had also spoken to Cippi Palacios and Erchelia V. DISCUSS AND CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENTS:

City Manager Gary Broz requested to pass on this agenda item.

DISCUSS AND TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION TO CONSIDER PAYMENT OF CURRENT BILLS:

City Manager Gary Broz reported that the current bill amount is \$89,602.53. Councilperson Callis made motion to approve payment of current bills amount of \$63,388.90. Councilperson Vasquez seconded the motion. All voted AYE. Motion carried.

CITY STAFF REPORTS:

“At this time, city Council will hear reports/updates on all committees or department assignments, which may include, but is not limited to the following: Police Department-grant updates, police reports; Director of Utilities-park reports, water & sewer updates; Street Department-repairs/projects; Code Enforcement-progress reports; City Manager & City Secretary-public information; Jonas Titus -Victoria Economic Development.” No formal action can be taken on these items.

City Manager Gary Broz reported that Police Department should be moved into the new building early November.

Audit is moving along.

Pictures were shown of the updated work at Shelby Hall; Money spent was approximately \$26,000; possibly working on the outside of the building in the future.

Grants moving along slowly;

Lights at Cowboy statue for Friday night football.

Working towards a city-wide cleanup date; possibly November and April

Gilbert Road Project: flags are out where pipe will be installed.

Jaime, Joseph, Andy and Street Department team have done a good job on mowing; starting to

see

at the end of the tunnel.

Samantha is working diligently on code enforcement; N. Kleas and Carver School; and

Finance Director Diane Pierce was absent.

Street Superintendent Andy Brzozowski reported they have been busy mowing, placing culvert pipes in on Cedar and Washington streets, and fixing potholes.

Director of Utilities Brad Ryan stated there has been a few water leaks.

Monday replacing the bearings on orbitor at the Water Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Chief of Police Rick Boone reported they will be parking cars at the football game tomorrow night; a big turnout is expected, and extra police officers will be at the football game of Industrial Cobras versus Edna Cowboys.

The new Police Department is looking good, and they are ready to move in.

During a recent traffic stop, \$47,500 was seized.

Junior High fight was reported on.

Victoria Economic Development Jonas Titus stated he is working on 3 projects
