Notice is hereby given about a meeting of the City Council of Edna, Texas to be held on **Thursday, September 03, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.** at **Edna City Hall, 126 W. Main, Edna, Texas**, for the purpose of considering the following agenda items. All agenda items are subject to action and public comment. City Council reserves the right to convene into closed/executive session on any agenda item in compliance with and allowed by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 Government Code, Vernon's Texas Code, Annotated (V.T.C.A.)

1. Call Meeting to Order / Moment of Silence / Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Approve the minutes of the Budget Workshop held August 19, 2026 and regular city council meeting held August 20, 2026.
3. Public Comments:
"During the council meeting, as each item is addressed, the council shall also allow the audience to speak on any subject matter that is posted on the agenda in accordance with HB 2840. The council may not take action on any item which has not been posted on the agenda." Please limit – two minutes
4. Discuss and consider awarding by resolution 2026-16 a contract for Administrative Services pertaining to the application and implementation, if awarded, of the City's 2027 Texas Community Development Block Grant Program- Community Development Fund (TxCDBG-CD) grant of the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) and authorizing the execution of a contract.
5. Discuss and consider awarding by resolution 2026-17 a contract for Administrative Services pertaining to the application and implementation, if awarded, of the City's 2028 Texas Community Development Block Grant Program- Community Development Fund (TxCDBG-CD) grant of the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) and authorizing the execution of a contract.
6. Discuss and consider the Jackson County Chamber of Commerce's request to close Main Street from Wells Street to Allen Street from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on October 31, 2026, for the Annual Halloween on Main event, and take any necessary action.
7. Consider request of interagency transfer to Fulton Police Department for one body Armor vest and declare the vest as surplus and take any action deemed necessary.
8. Conduct a public hearing on the proposed 2026/2027 City of Edna fiscal year budget and take any action deemed necessary.
9. Consider first reading of Ordinance No. 2025-07 an Ordinance of the City of Edna, Texas adopting the budget of the City of Edna, Texas for fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2026; and ending on September 30, 2027. Appropriating the various amounts thereof; repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and declaring an effective date.
10. Conduct a public hearing on the proposed 2026/2027 tax rate, establish the tax rate and tax levy, and levy ad valorem taxes for the City of Edna.
11. Consider first reading of Ordinance No. 2025-08 an Ordinance of the City of Edna, Texas setting the tax rate and tax levy and valorem taxes for the City of Edna, Texas for the year 2026/2027 repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and declaring an effective date.

12. Discuss and consider adding section (7k) to Police Department FLSA Overtime Policy and take any action deemed necessary.
13. Discuss and consider budget amendments.
14. Discuss and take appropriate action to consider payment of current bills.
