Notice is hereby given about a meeting of the City Council of Edna, Texas to be held on Thursday, March 5, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. at Edna City Hall, 126 W. Main, Edna, Texas, for the purpose of considering the following agenda items. All agenda items are subject to action and public comment. City Council reserves the right to convene into closed/executive session on any agenda item in compliance with and allowed by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 Government Code, Vernon's Texas Code, Annotated (V.T.C.A.)

1. Call Meeting to Order / Moment of Silence / Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Approve the minutes of the city council meeting held February 19, 2026.
3. Public Comments:

"During the council meeting, as each item is addressed, the council shall also allow the audience to speak on any subject matter that is posted on the agenda in accordance with HB 2840. The council may not take action on any item which has not been posted on the agenda." Please limit – two minutes
4. Consider Resolution 2026-08, awarding a contract for Grant Administration Services pertaining to the application and implementation, if awarded, of the City's Community Development Block Grant- Disaster Recovery (CBDG-DR), Local Communities Program (LCP) funding from the Texas General Land Office (GLO) under the 2024 Disasters DR-4781 Texas Severe Storms and DR-4798, Hurricane Beryl and Authoring execution of a contract.
5. Consider closure of Ed Linn Street between Main St. and Houston St. for the Jackson County Cares, Walk with You Cancer Walk on April 18, 2026 and take any action deemed necessary.
6. Consider accepting the Annual Racial Profile Report from the Edna Police Department and take any action deemed necessary.
7. Consider approval of Certification of Unopposed Candidates and take any action deemed necessary.
8. Conduct First reading of Ordinance #2026-03, Cancelling the Municipal Election to be held on May 2, 2026.
9. Discuss and take action to submit grant application to the Texas Water Development Bond under HB 500 Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant Program for Water System Improvements and take any action deemed necessary.

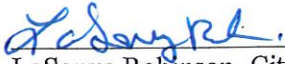
14. Take action as a result of the executive session.
