<b>Action Item 2</b>	<b>Ordinance - Classification Plan</b>
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Ordinance of by the governing authority of the City of Warner Robins that the City Classification Plan is amended as follows:

Create the position of Sanitation Customer Service Specialist, Job Class # 447, Grade # 13, authorized strength of 1, Public Works Stormwater Department.

Increase the authorized strength of Administrative Secretary (REC), Job Class # 734, Grade # 10, Parks and Recreation Department by one to authorized strength of 3.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City’s Finance department is hereby authorized to transfer funds between departments and between line items within a department in the Fiscal Year 2024 budget, as necessary to facilitate the changes to the City’s classification plan enumerated in this ordinance.
