

**City of Battlefield
Board of Aldermen
Regular Session Meeting Minutes
March 3, 2026**

Item 1 Ceremonial Matters.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Alderman Rocky Compton
Opening Prayer was led by Alderman Scott Campbell.

Item 2 Roll Call.

City Clerk Beth Anne West completed Roll call with the Following Board members present: Scott Campbell, Rocky Compton, Tim Kelley Sr., and Matt McNitt. Board of Aldermen members absent were Aldermen Samantha Forbes and Doug Cunio. City Clerk Beth Anne West stated there was a quorum and the meeting could be held. Staff present were Interim City Administrator Chris McPhail, Building Inspector Trey Davis, Interim Police Chief Brent Armstrong, and City Clerk Beth Anne West.

- Mayor Mark Crabtree attended Legislative Conference held by Missouri Municipal League in Jefferson City in February 2026 met with legislators. The bill that Springfield was trying to approve that would have affected in negative manner died in the legislative process, so they may try again. Mayor Mark Crabtree mentioned various legislation against property tax but mentioned there will have to be something to replace it sustain the loss of the tax.

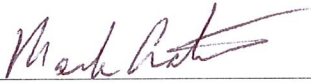

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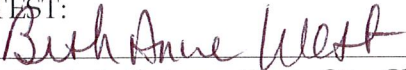
