4) New Business

a) **Stone Meadow Preliminary Plat**

- i) Major Subdivision Procedure (Review of Code 405.200-330)
- ii) Owner's Presentation by their Engineer- Mr. Larry Jensen provided information on the project and stated that an approval letter was received by Toth Engineering here recently. Mr. Jensen discussed areas of concern specifically with adjoining property owners that have fences that encroach on the boundary lines and may need conveyance to correct (about 20 feet) West end of common area. Mr. Jensen spoke of the discharge to south of retention area, mentioning the diversion berm would fan the water out to the street of the new subdivision and to detention basin and into existing paved ditch and into existing retention area. . Mr. Jensen noted that both Lewis and Hutchinson roads would connect to the existing roads and there would be a total of 42 lots. Lot 72 was still up for discussion. Mr. Jensen stated that adjustments may need to be made in relation to the detention basin. Mr. Jensen stated that Hines and Schaffer did the survey work on existing landmarks and 2 other surveys were done plus Mike White of White Surveying that all say it is correct, so everyone is confident the pins are correct and the plat calls it out. Mr. Miller from Toth Engineering indicated his staff completed the review per the submittal who went through the revisions only outstanding item is the approval of the plat and he recommended such approval.
