This Summer:

The Sun Bucks program provides eligible school-aged children with a \$120 grocery benefit to help families purchase nutritious foods and enjoy meals together throughout the summer

Why SUN Bucks?

- Eligible school-aged children may receive \$120 in grocery benefits for the summer.
- SUN Bucks can be used alongside other programs like Summer Meals, SNAP, and WIC.
- Gives families more flexibility to purchase foods their children enjoy while helping keep kids nourished during summer break

*SNAP = Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

*WIC = Women, Infants, and Children Program
