Daniel Franklin gave a brief explanation of the capabilities of the mobile app. The board discussed that it would be useful to have these areas mentioned in the app:

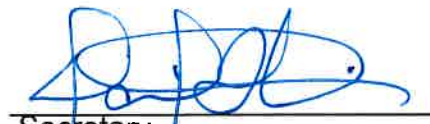
1. Beal Park
