Mayor Bickers called the meeting to order at 6:07 PM after the Public Hearing for rezoning the Finley property 3371 Louisville Road.

Mayor Bickers led the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

MOTION by Gormley to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2022, meeting of the BMA. Second by Holley. VOTE: UNANIMOUS. **MOTION PASSES.**

Mayor's Report and Approval of Monthly Financial Report:

MOTION by Holley to accept the April monthly financial report. Second by Gormley. VOTE: UNANIMOUS. **MOTION PASSES.**

Mayor Bickers communicated that the annual Louisville Cleanup scheduled for May 07, 2022 was cancelled due to stormy and rainy weather. The event will be rescheduled for later in the summer.

Mayor Bickers communicated that the results of the 2021 audit by the State of Tennessee has been received. There were no negative findings.

Resolutions and Ordinances:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF LOUISVILLE, TENNESSEE, AMENDING THE ZONING OF PARCEL 159.28 LOCATED AT 3371 LOUISVILLE ROAD AT THE REQUEST OF THE PROPERTY OWNER (Second Reading)

Mayor Bickers reviewed the background concerning this request by the property owner. Mayor Bickers noted that a Public Hearing concerning this request was held prior to the BMA meeting. There were no citizen comments and the Public Hearing was closed.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF LOUISVILLE, TENNESSEE, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2023 (First Reading)

Mayor Bickers reviewed the proposed budget.

MOTION by Bickers to approve the ordinance as proposed. Second by Holley.
VOTE: UNANIMOUS. MOTION PASSES

Other Action Items:

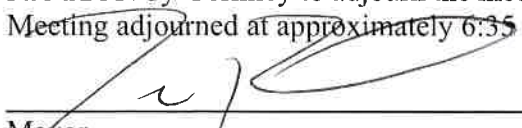
1. Review and approval for a new vehicle: Mayor Bickers reviewed the bids received for a new Chevy Trailblazer for Town errands and administrative travel. West Chevrolet was the low bidder at \$21,195, which was \$4-5,000 less than two other bids.

MOTION by Bickers to approve placing the order with West Chevrolet for \$21,195. Second by Holley. **VOTE: UNANIMOUS. MOTION PASSES**

2. Review of preliminary design for playground: Mayor Bickers reviewed the status of design for the playground. The Mayor submitted copies of the playground detailed proposal received from Playworld. The information includes cost estimates for the proposal. The cost will depend on final selection of equipment and play surface. The Mayor requested the

Alderman review the design, cost and return comments. The Mayor will send a pdf file for review. Future meetings will be scheduled to gather broader comments.

MOTION by Gormley to adjourn the meeting; Second by Bickers, VOTE: UNANIMOUS.
