Resolutions and Ordinances: None

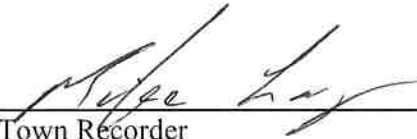
Other Action Items:

1. Update on Road Improvements: Town Engineer Swicegood provided an update. All work at Pride Road is complete. Paving and striping are complete on Miser Station Road. Work remains on stop bars at the four-way intersection. Additionally, thermoplastic rumble strips will be applied on Saturday, September 17. PRI will start applying shoulder stone the week of September 19-23.
