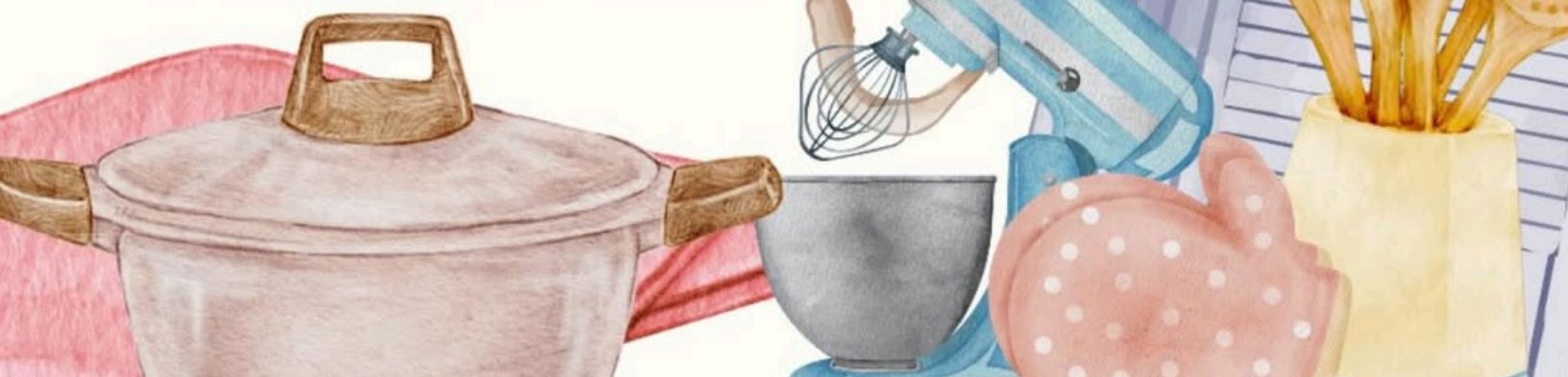

WHY WIRED EARBUDS?

SMMS strongly encourages students to use wired earbuds at school.

- Kentucky law requires schools to remain cell phone-free, and wireless earbuds can tempt students to connect to phones for music, apps, or other distractions during the school day.
- The school is not responsible for lost or stolen earbuds. Wireless earbuds are often misplaced and can be expensive to replace.
- Wireless earbuds must also be charged regularly, adding another responsibility for students during the school day.
- Students sometimes share wireless earbuds, which can spread germs.
- For these reasons, wired earbuds are the best and simplest option for school use.

MARSHALL COUNTY BAG POLICY

District Policy does not permit backpacks/computer bags for middle school students. Students may bring **one** bag that will fit in a 12"x12"x12" box. Boxes will be used during the bag check process to check for fidelity of this rule. This does not include sports bags for practice after school. Those are stored during the school day. All bags will pass through our threat detector machines.

Chromebook sleeves are mandatory for students to carry their Chromebooks around the school. This helps protect their device from damage. These can stay at school. (maximum size, 8"x12')

Important Information – Free Summer Meals (Please Read Carefully):

- Pre-registration is required for meal kit pick-up. Parent/guardian must complete the form in advance**
- Student names will be recorded at the time of meal pick-up.**
- Each meal kit includes: 7 breakfasts, 7 lunches, 46 ounces of 100% fruit juice, and a gallon of milk.**
- Only Parent or legal guardians (as verified in Infinite Campus) may pick up meals without child(ren) present.**
- If a parent/guardian is unable to pick up the meals, the children must be present with the adult collecting on their behalf.**
