- Darby Creek Excavating, Inc., curb, gutter, and underdrain installation at East Street in the amount of \$61,089.12.

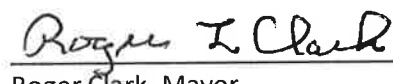
COUNCIL COMMENTS
