ORDINANCES FOR THIRD READING

2024-17 AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE NEXT YEAR'S EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, BASED UPON THE CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED RESOURCES ISSUED BY THE PICKAWAY COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2025, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Roger Clark moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to have the Third Reading. All votes were yay. After the reading, Roger Clark moved, seconded by Chad Noggle, to accept the Third Reading. All votes were yay.

2024-18 AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND REPLACE THE ASHVILLE CODIFIED ORDINANCE PART ELEVEN - PLANNING AND ZONING CODE, TITLE ONE – PLANNING AND ZONING ADMINISTRATION; TITLE THREE – ZONING DISTRICT REGULATIONS; TITLE FIVE – ADDITIONAL ZONING REGULATIONS; AND TITLE SEVEN - SUBDIVISION DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENTS (EXCEPT APPENDICES A – C SHALL REMAIN IN THEIR CURRENT STATE). 2024-20 AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE RATE OF PAY FOR ALL VILLAGE EMPLOYEES (POLICE

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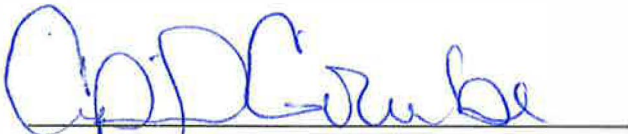

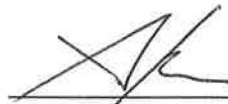
