The Council of Ashville convened in Regular Session from 6:30 PM to 6:48 PM in the Charles K. Wise Council Chambers at 200 East Station Street, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Mayor Welsh called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and requested a moment of silence.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Randy Loveless moved, seconded by Matt Scholl, to approve the minutes for the July 7, 2025 Regular Session as presented. All votes were yay.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

POLICE: Lt. Cline reported that the department just hired Jimmy Ford and that the department is still down two officers.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Trackside Bar Liquor Permit Renewal – Colton Henson moved, seconded by Chad Noggle, to waive a hearing for the liquor permit renewal for Trackside. All votes were yay.
- Westside Park Impact Fees Request – Colton Henson moved, seconded by Chad Noggle, to approve the request to use \$47K of Impact Fees to construct a shelter house at the Westside Park. All votes were yay.
- Pickleball/Basketball Court Lighting Impact Fees Request – Colton Henson asked what prompted the need for lighting and have the neighbors been consulted. Bert Cline said the neighbors have not been consulted. Matt Scholl asked why the \$750K CDBG that the Village qualified for couldn't be used for the lighting. Cline said that the grant can be used for sidewalks and street repairs around the park and that's where he would like to spend the money. Henson asked if there was a comprehensive plan for the park as he believes a cohesive flow would be better than piecing it together. Henson suggested coming up with a plan before making any changes. Dave Rainey said it's a bad look if the Village spends \$30K on lights when there are areas that need more attention. After discussion, Roger Clark moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to approve the request. Roger Clark and Randy Loveless voted yay with Chad Noggle, Dave Rainey, Matt Scholl, and Colton Henson voting No.

MAYOR COMMENTS: Mayor Welsh gave street paving updates.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

- Chad Noggle commended Bert Cline on the update he posted on Facebook. Noggle said he was
