TIME GUIDELINES BY GRADE

Grade Level	Frequency	Time Per Night
Pre-K & Kindergarten	2-3 times/week	up to 20 minutes
Grades 1 & 2	3-4 times/week	up to 30 minutes
Grades 3-5	3-4 times/week	up to 45 minutes

HOW FAMILIES CAN SUPPORT

- Provide a quiet, distraction-free space for homework.
- Encourage a consistent homework routine.
- Offer support and encouragement, but allow independence.
- Communicate with teachers if concerns arise.
