2025 Recognition of Excellence in Supporting Special Education Awards

Honoring exceptional educators, programs, parents, and students who go above and beyond what is typical and expected to positively impact and set a standard of excellence for the success of students with disabilities.



The Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) is currently accepting nominations of educators, staff, programs, parents and students who demonstrate excellence in the LCPS special education community and who inspire others to do the same.

The Recognition of Excellence in Special Education Awards honor those who have gone **above-and-beyond what is typical and what is expected** to include, support, and create opportunities to shine for students with various types of visible and invisible disabilities, and celebrates the extraordinary impact these exceptional people have on the personal and academic success, self-esteem, sense of belonging and meaningful inclusion for students with disabilities throughout LCPS.

Online nominations must be received by midnight Friday, March 21, 2025. Nomination statements should be up to 300 words and must provide **specific examples** of the award criteria in order for the submission to be considered. Nominations received after the deadline will not be accepted or considered. **To nominate, scan the QR code or click on the link below and follow the instructions.** Nominations may not be edited once submitted. Nominations will be reviewed by SEAC, and award recipients will be selected by SEAC. Winners will be notified around the first week of May 2025.

Please note that this is a highly competitive process, and the selection of winners is at the sole discretion of SEAC. The rationale for not selecting a nominee will not be provided. **It is the responsibility of the nominator to ensure that the information provided on the nomination is correct, completed in full, and submitted before the deadline.**
