Subject: Adopted Secondary School Attendance Zone Changes for the 2026-2027 School Year



On [June 10, 2025](#), the Loudoun County School Board adopted changes to Dulles South area middle and high school attendance zones, including Gum Spring Middle School/John Champe High School, J. Michael Lunsford Middle School/Freedom High School, and Willard Middle School/Lightridge High School. An [adopted attendance zone map](#) is viewable from the [LCPS dedicated secondary school attendance zone webpage](#). The attendance zone changes will take effect with the start of the 2026-2027 school year.

If you are not sure if the secondary schools serving your residence will change, use the [LCPS Attendance Boundary E-Listing](#) for your home address and select '2026-2027 School Year.'

Guided by [Policy 8160, Exceptions to School Assignment Due to Attendance Zone Change](#), and School Board direction on June 10, 2025, current grade 7 students who will be assigned to a different middle school next fall may have the option to potentially remain at their current school for grade 8. Also, current grade 9, 10 and 11 students who have been assigned to another school may also have an option to potentially remain at and graduate from their current high school. Current grade 11 students, who will be seniors in the 2026-2027 school year, are allowed to remain at and graduate from their current high school. More information will be sent directly to the identified families later this month from LCPS Planning & GIS Services staff.
