Four athletes from Paint Rock competed in the UIL Region II-A Division II Track and Field Championships on April 25 and 26 at Angelo State University. The four athletes were Baily Balderas, Madison Harlow, Marie Mastroianni, and Jazmin Santiago. The girls placed 10th as a team out of 29 teams at the regional meet.

Sophomore, Madison Harlow placed 3rd in the 3200m run and 3rd in the 1600m run. Harlow's time in the 3200m was a 13:30 and a 5:55 in the 1600m.

Junior, Baily Balderas placed 3rd in the 100m hurdles with a time of 16.95 and with the "wildcard" draw qualified for the UIL State Track and Field Championships. Baily will compete in the state track meet on May 10th in Austin.
