Three (3) letters of reference <u>must</u> accompany the application. They may be from teachers, employers, school counselors, school administrators, and/or community leaders. The student will supply a signed letter telling about his/her self, extracurricular activities, participation in school functions and educational goals.

Return the application, transcript, three letters of reference and the personal letter to the American Legion Auxiliary at the address below by March 17, 2023. After the application is reviewed you will be notified if awarded.

Our Scholarship Committee comprised of the Education Chairperson and three (3) Auxiliary members will judge all applications. Their decision is final.
