The American Legion Auxiliary, Titusville Unit #1 is awarding three (3) scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each for students obtaining a high school diploma in North Brevard.

All scholarship grants require the student to be a Florida resident who attends a College, Community College or a Technical School within the United States.

Priority consideration will be given to students who qualify under the following criteria but these criteria are NOT mandatory.

1. Is the applicant or a parent a member of the American Legion or the American Legion Auxiliary? If so, what Post? _____
2. Is a parent in the military or was honorably discharged? _____
3. Is the student a member of the ROTC or NJROTC? _____
4. Needs financial help to further their education in the field of their choice? _____

Consideration will be based on grades. **(Please provide a sealed transcript).**

Three (3) letters of reference must accompany the application. They may be from teachers, employers, school counselors, school administrators, and/or community leaders. The student will supply a signed letter telling about his/her self, extracurricular activities, participation in school functions and educational goals.

Return the application, transcript, three letters of reference and the personal letter to the American Legion Auxiliary at the address below by March 15, 2024. After the application is reviewed you will be notified if awarded.

Our Scholarship Committee comprised of the Education Chairperson and three (3) Auxiliary members will judge all applications. Their decision is final.

Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the school of your choice for tuition and/or books. You may email me at donna.shearer46@gmail.com.
