Data from FAST

- FAST is new for the 2022-2023 school year and teachers are analyzing data to address gaps and areas of needed support
- After school clubs and tutoring has been incorporated to help bridge gaps
- Teachers will utilize FAST data along with iReady data to monitor student progress

Cell Phone Policy

- Interim superintendent had provided a new cell phone policy for wireless communication due 2/24
- Wireless communication devices “WCD” includes computers, tablets, ereaders, cell phones, telephones, smartphones, pagers, or other web- enabled devices. District is noticing issues with disruption, distraction, exposure, and inappropriate content
- On school property or school related functions, they either must be powered completely off or placed into vibrate/ silent and stored out of sight during school hours.
- Audubon will follow the new contract and will adhere to district policy for communications with principal authority to interpret the guidelines
- Cell phones are not allowed on school busses to or from school, unless using the phone to scan their bus pass momentarily

School Advisory Council Meeting

- Students must have cell phones in their backpacks, if a student does not follow directions, a warning will be given, and if necessary, an administrator will remove the phone from the student. Audubon will aim to return the phone by the end of the day
- Students shall have no expectation of confidentiality with respect to their use of WCDs on school premises/ property
- Possession of WCD by a student at school during school hours and/or during extra- curricular activities is a privilege that may be forfeited by any student who fails to abide by these terms or abuses this privilege
